| <b>HB 273</b>  | <b>TOOMY</b>    | <b>DISTRICT ATTORNEYS/ASST :</b> Omnibus assistant district attorney bill   |
| <b>HB 291</b>  | <b>TOOMY</b>    | <b>SUNSET LAW:</b> Re-creates the Department of Justice   |
| <b>HB 420</b>  | <b>MURRAY</b>   | <b>CLERKS OF COURT:</b> Authorizes the Clerk of the Orleans Parish Civil District Court to purchase or lease a motor vehicle for the use of his office      |
| <b>HB 589</b>  | <b>FAUCHEUX</b> | <b>HOLIDAYS:</b> Provides for state holidays for the clerks of court in St. James and St. John the Baptist Parishes   |
| <b>HB 664</b>  | <b>CAZAYOUX</b> | <b>JURY DUTY:</b> Increases fees for jury service   |
| <b>HB 729</b>  | <b>JOHNS</b>    | <b>COURTS:</b> Provides scope of appellate review for claims against the state  |
| <b>HB 801</b>  | <b>TOOMY</b>    | <b>JUDGES:</b> Requires the Judicial Council to adopt guidelines for the approval of the creation of new judgeships   |
| <b>HB 935</b>  | <b>BROOME</b>   | <b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for a reduction of court costs for grandparents seeking custodial rights of their grandchildren                            |
| <b>HB 1109</b> | <b>MARTINY</b>  | <b>JUVENILES:</b> Provides for an exception to confidentiality provisions regarding juveniles for purposes of child abduction alert systems                 |
| <b>HB 1117</b> | <b>DOWNER</b>   | <b>LAW ENFORCEMENT:</b> Provides with respect to the rights of law enforcement officers while under investigation   |

<b>HB 1142</b>	<b>DOWNER</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS:</b> Provides for training requirements of La. National Guard military police
<b>HB 1293</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>SHERIFFS:</b> Provides that either the sheriff or the governing authority of the parish may obtain reimbursement for certain expenses from inmates in parish prisons
<b>HB 1467</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:</b> Authorizes retail distribution center permits for commercial airlines and prohibits local permits or fees
<b>HB 1476</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>INSURERS:</b> Allows unauthorized insurers to file lawsuits and enter pleadings without posting a bond, if placed on an approved list by the Department of Insurance
<b>SB 40</b>	<b>SCHEDLER (TBA)</b>	<b>JUVENILES:</b> Rescinds confidentiality provisions regarding juvenile crime victims for the purposes of child abduction alert systems, such as the AMBER Alert network. <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>SB 285</b>	<b>LENTINI</b>	<b>ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:</b> Authorizes retail distribution center permits for commercial airlines and prohibits local permits or fees.
