<b>HB 1110</b>	<b>FAUCHEUX</b>	<b>GAMBLING/RIVERBOAT:</b> Amends definition of designated gaming area
<b>HB 1282</b>	<b>TRICHE</b>	<b>CHILDREN/SUPPORT:</b> Authorizes the interception of gaming winnings for the collection of past due child support
<b>HB 1633</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING:</b> Provides relative to the execution of the casino support services contract
<b>HB 1724</b>	<b>POWELL</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE:</b> Increases the salaries of members of Board of Pardons
<b>HB 1846</b>	<b>FAUCHEUX</b>	<b>CRIME:</b> Provides for the crime of unlawful use of body armor
<b>HB 1914</b>	<b>HUTTER</b>	<b>GAMBLING:</b> Defines amusement devices
<b>HB 1984</b>	<b>G SMITH</b>	<b>CRIME/HOMICIDE:</b> Provides with respect to first degree murder
<b>SB 479</b>	<b>CHAISSON</b>	<b>ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:</b> Defines passengers in the "open container" prohibition and provides exclusions for certain operators, passengers, and areas of the motor vehicle.
<b>SB 1019</b>	<b>C D JONES</b>	<b>VIDEO POKER:</b> Provides with respect to the Video Draw Poker Devices Control Law that imposes a two-year residence and domicile requirement on certain gaming applicants.
