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| HB 256 | BOWLER (TBA) | ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE: (Constitutional Amendment) Provides with respect to a system of administrative law (Subject to Rules Suspension) |
| HB 430 | MURRAY | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Relative to campaign contributions made by persons substantially interested in the gaming industry, removes certain prohibitions |
| HB 481 | LANCASTER | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Relative to forty-eight hour reports, increases amount of contributions to district and major office candidates or political committees supporting or opposing such candidates that require such reporting |
| HB 482 | LANCASTER | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Requires persons who make independent expenditures or accept contributions in excess of certain amounts in candidate elections to file forty-eight hour reports in the twenty days prior to the election |
| HB 510 | MONTGOMERY | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Provides for limitations on campaign contributions made to the commissioner of insurance and public service commissioners by persons under their jurisdiction |
| HB 530 | LANCASTER | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Changes civil penalties for any person who makes a contribution in the name of another person |
| HB 533 | LANCASTER | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Provides that the offices of marshal and constable of a city court are district offices for purposes of campaign finance laws |
| HB 765 | CAZAYOUX | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Prohibits legislators from accepting certain campaign contributions during certain legislative sessions |
| HB 809 | LANCASTER | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Provides that certain offices of a board or governing authority with a municipality with more than a certain population within its jurisdiction are district level offices for purposes of Campaign Finance Disclosure Law |
| HB 841 | LANCASTER | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Prohibits legislators from accepting certain campaign contributions during certain legislative sessions |
| HB 1015 | LANCASTER | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Prohibits the governor from accepting certain campaign contributions during certain legislative sessions and for a period of 30 days thereafter |
| HB 1126 | MURRAY | CAMPAIGN FINANCE: Requires persons who make independent expenditures or accept contributions in |

excess of certain amounts in candidate elections to file
forty-eight hour reports in the twenty-days prior to the
election
