| <b>HB 577</b>  | <b>M JACKSON</b>  | <b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for the constructive contempt of court   |
| <b>HB 624</b>  | <b>BOWLER</b>     | <b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for jurisdiction over orders for custody, visitation, and support                              |
| <b>HB 750</b>  | <b>DURAND</b>     | <b>VITAL STATISTICS:</b> Provides relative to the release of birth and death certificates for judicial purposes                 |
| <b>HB 1011</b> | <b>JOHNS</b>      | <b>PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE:</b> Provides relative to the terms of options and rights of first refusal                                |
