| <b>HB 255</b> | <b>ANSARDI</b>      | <b>RETIREMENT/LOCAL</b> Repeals provisions of law relative to the Firemen's Pension and Relief Fund for the City of Kenner  |
| <b>HB 316</b> | <b>CURTIS</b>       | <b>RETIREMENT/LOCAL</b> Defines "earnable compensation" for the City of Alexandria Employees' Retirement System   |
| <b>HB 457</b> | <b>DURAND (TBA)</b> | <b>RETIREMENT/STATE EMPS</b> Increases the employee contributions of adult probation and parole officers and provides for a higher accrual rate for certain such officers ( <i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i> ) |
| <b>HB 478</b> | <b>HEATON</b>       | <b>RETIREMENT/JUDGES - CT OFF</b> Provides for cost-of-living adjustments for judges and surviving spouses of judges who did not opt to become members of the retirement system                                 |
| <b>HCR 28</b> | <b>TUCKER</b>       | <b>RETIREMENT/FEDERAL</b> Authorizes a divided vote referendum option for Medicare coverage for certain state employees   |
| <b>HCR 81</b> | <b>CROWE</b>        | <b>SOCIAL SECURITY SYS</b> Requests congress to support no increases in payroll taxes, no cuts to Social Security benefits, and optional Social Security Personal Retirement Accounts                           |
