HB 1069	PIERRE	CONSERVATION Provides relative to the priorities for conservation, allocation, and rationing of intrastate natural gas supplies in the event of an emergency
HB 1070	HOPKINS	PROPERTY/PUBLIC Provides relative to transfer of property in Caddo Parish from the state to lessees
HB 1086	DOVE	COASTAL RESOURCES Requires Department of Natural Resources to submit an annual report on the status of barrier island projects and needs
HB 1105	DANIEL	COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE To include restoration and conservation of coastal forested wetlands in the state's overall coastal protection plan
HB 1135	FRITH	PROPERTY/PUBLIC Authorizes the transfer of property in Vermilion Parish from Department of Wildlife and Fisheries
