<b>HB 214</b>	<b>FANNIN</b>	<b>TAX/SEVERANCE TAX</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Increases the limitation on parish allocations for severance taxes on minerals
<b>HB 541</b>	<b>ARNOLD</b>	<b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> Adds water transportation company to definition of public service property
<b>HB 639</b>	<b>JEFFERSON</b>	<b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> Changes provisions regarding interruption and suspension of prescription for procedures affecting property sold at tax sales
<b>HB 649</b>	<b>SALTER</b>	<b>TAX APPEALS/BOARD</b> Provides for penalties for frivolous appeals of tax assessments
<b>HB 696</b>	<b>MONTGOMERY</b>	<b>REVENUE DEPARTMENT</b> Provides with respect to settlement offers made by taxpayers
<b>HB 714</b>	<b>GALLOT</b>	<b>TAX/SEVERANCE TAX</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Increases the general severance tax allocation to parishes
<b>HB 966</b>	<b>TOWNSEND</b>	<b>TAX/TAXATION</b> Provides for the eligibility of certain video poker license holders to participate in the tax incentive programs under the enterprise zone program
<b>HB 1003</b>	<b>SALTER</b>	<b>TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL-EXEM</b> Exempts prescription drugs purchased pursuant to Medicare Part D plans
