<b>HB 28</b>	<b>BRUNEAU</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits the expropriation and transfer of property to a private person
<b>HB 29</b>	<b>MONTGOMERY</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits the expropriation and transfer of property to a private person
<b>HB 84</b>	<b>SMITH, GARY</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits the expropriation and transfer of property to a private person
<b>HB 95</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> Prohibits the expropriation of property for certain private, nongovernmental purposes
<b>HB 131</b>	<b>WALSWORTH</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the limitation of expropriation authority for economic development
<b>HB 133</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE/RECORDS</b> Provides that fees paid for copying medical records includes certification of those records
<b>HB 239</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits the expropriation and transfer of property to a private person
<b>HB 260</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Revises definitions under the state and private medical malpractice acts
<b>HB 357</b>	<b>BAUDOIN</b>	<b>LIABILITY/TORTS</b> Provides for solidary liability for damages caused by the disposal, storage, handling, or transportation of hazardous or toxic substances
<b>HB 412</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Provides relative to definitions in medical malpractice
<b>HB 414</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the preparation and signing of judgments
<b>HB 455</b>	<b>LAFONTA (TBA)</b>	<b>LIABILITY/CIVIL</b> Limits liability of faith-based organizations acting as shelters and individuals transporting persons to shelters during a natural disaster <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>HB 462</b>	<b>HEBERT (TBA)</b>	<b>ELECTIONS/CANDIDATES</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides that certain persons who are nominated or appointed to fill a vacancy in a statewide elective office shall not be eligible to be a candidate in the next election for such office <b>(Technical Review Only) (Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>

<b>HB 464</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> Requires legislative approval for the expropriation of property
<b>HB 559</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>CHILDREN/ABUSE</b> Limits the content of any petition issued in a child abuse case
<b>HB 640</b>	<b>SCHNEIDER</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits the expropriation and transfer of property to a private person
<b>HB 707</b>	<b>FARRAR</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides procedures for the expropriation of property
<b>HB 716</b>	<b>BEARD (TBA)</b>	<b>STATE OFFICIALS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the filling of a vacancy in a statewide elective office other than the office of governor <b>(Technical Review Only) (Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>HB 992</b>	<b>MARCHAND</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> Defines public use for purposes of the taking of property
<b>HB 1131</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>LIABILITY/CIVIL</b> Provides relative to comparative fault
<b>HB 1163</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> Provides for the right of a property owner to repurchase his expropriated property under certain circumstances
<b>HB 1167</b>	<b>THOMPSON</b>	<b>LIABILITY/TORTS</b> Provides an exemption from liability for pilots providing gratuitous medical transportation services
<b>SB 1</b>	<b>MCPHERSON</b>	<b>EXPROPRIATION</b> Constitutional amendment to prohibit the expropriation of property for use by certain private entities; to prohibit the transfer of expropriated property to private entities without first offering to the original owner; and to define "public purpose" for expropriation. (2/3-CA12s1(A))
