<b>HB 473</b>	<b>WINSTON</b>	<b>HUMAN SERVICES</b> Provides with respect to domicile of the Florida Parishes Human Services Authority
<b>HB 663</b>	<b>LAMBERT</b>	<b>MENTAL HEALTH</b> Repeals the moratorium on the licensure of mental health clinics
<b>HB 875</b>	<b>TOWNSEND</b>	<b>SANITARY CODE</b> Provides relative to retail food establishments
<b>HB 896</b>	<b>WALSWORTH</b>	<b>PHYSICIANS</b> Provides for physician discounts for rendered health care services
<b>HB 897</b>	<b>MCDONALD</b>	<b>HOSPITALS</b> Allows a hospital to operate an ambulance service solely to transport its own patients between parts of its own campus under certain circumstances
<b>HB 1243</b>	<b>FARRAR</b>	<b>ELDERLY</b> Creates a Silver Alert system for missing senior citizens
<b>HB 1247</b>	<b>DEWITT</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES</b> Provides relative to audits of Medicaid cost reports for intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded
<b>HB 1254</b>	<b>DURAND</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE</b> Changes the membership of the Louisiana Emergency Response Network Board
<b>HB 1324</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>HEALTH</b> Requires automatic external defibrillators in primary offices of municipal governing authorities and certain hotels
