| <b>HCR 180 HUTTER</b>        | <b>LA RECOVERY AUTH</b> Urges and requests the Louisiana Recovery Authority to develop and prepare an Action Plan to use Community Development Block Grant funds to redeem, purchase, defease, or otherwise retire not less than 50% of the bonds of the Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation |
| <b>HB 408 HUNTER</b>         | <b>ELDERLY</b> Provides for the distribution of funds to parish councils on aging in the event of a disaster   |
| <b>HB 504 POWELL, M.</b>     | <b>TEACHERS/SALARY</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Relative to a state salary supplement for classroom teachers, requires that a certain portion of any increase in the official revenue forecast be used for this purpose  |
| <b>HB 591 CRANE</b>          | <b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Increases limit on appropriations to BESE and the Board of Regents for administrative costs related to the La. Quality Education Support Fund   |
| <b>HB 657 SALTER</b>         | <b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Authorizes the state to forgive the debt owed to the state by the Sabine River Authority  |
| <b>HB 925 WALKER</b>         | <b>STATE AGENCIES</b> Authorizes the creation of charter agencies  |
| <b>HB 1028 HOPKINS (TBA)</b> | <b>INSURANCE/GROUP-STATE</b> Permits state legislators who have served in the legislature and participated in Office of Group Benefits sponsored programs for 12 years to remain eligible for participation <b>(SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION)</b>  |
| <b>HB 1287 GRAY</b>          | <b>STUDENT/TUITION</b> Provides tuition and mandatory fee exemptions at public postsecondary education institutions for certain persons previously in the state's foster care program  |
