HB 2	TOWNSEND	CAPITAL OUTLAY Provides for the comprehensive capital outlay budget
HB 14	SCHNEIDER	TAX/INCOME-CREDIT Provides a tax deduction for uninsured losses associated with natural disaster
HB 31	GREENE	TAX/INCOME-INDIV/CREDIT Provides for a child tax credit
HB 94	GREENE	TAX/INCOME-CREDIT Provides for a child tax credit
HB 152	HUTTER	TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT Provides state sales tax refunds for purchases of tangible personal property to replace, repair, improve, or rebuild damaged or destroyed businesses in a Hurricane Katrina or Rita disaster area
HB 191	GREENE	TAX/INCOME TAX Provides for a deduction from state income taxes for certain educational expenses associated with nonpublic schools
HB 232	TUCKER	TAX/INCOME-CREDIT Provides a tax credit for a certain portion of the premium for property and casualty insurance policies
HB 235	HUTTER	TAX CREDITS Authorizes an income tax credit for certain contributions made to public elementary and secondary schools
HB 239	HUTTER	TAX/INCOME-INDIV/CREDIT Authorizes an income tax credit for contributions made to school tuition organizations
HB 241	BALDONE	TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT Provides relative to an exclusion from state sales and use taxes for food purchases made by certain nonpublic schools
HB 259	TOOMY	TAX/INCOME-INDIV/CREDIT Provides for an individual income tax credit for certain volunteer firefighters
HB 271	FARRAR	TAX/TOBACCO TAX Provides relative to the excise tax on moist snuff
HB 300	SCHNEIDER	TAX/INCOME-INDIV/EXEMPT Provides for a tax deduction for certain casualty losses
HB 359	TOWNSEND	TAX EXEMPTIONS Provides relative to tax exemptions and credits in cultural product districts
HB 377	HUTTER	TAX CREDITS Provides tax credits for certain new, expanding, and returning businesses to parishes declared to be disaster areas as a result of Hurricane Katrina or Hurricane Rita

HB 495	TOWNSEND	TAX EXEMPTIONS Authorizes the exclusion of certain income derived from artistic works from state income taxation
HB 568	TOWNSEND	TAX EXEMPTIONS Authorizes a culinary arts and food science investor tax credit
HB 709	TOWNSEND	TAX CREDITS Cane River Heritage Area tax credit
HB 924	ODINET	TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT Provides for a state and local sales and use tax exemption for certain tangible personal property required to rebuild, repair, or replace certain storm-damaged property
HB 929	TRICHE	TAX CREDITS Provides for a tax credit for overpayments made by certain taxpayers under the Inventory Tax Credit
HB 940	BURRELL	TAX/INCOME-CREDIT Increases the tax credit for rehabilitation of certain owner-occupied residential or mixed use structures

HB 3	TOWNSEND	CAPITAL OUTLAY Provides for the Omnibus Bond Act
HB 123	KLECKLEY	TAX/OCCUPATIONAL Provides for an exclusion for gasoline sales from the definition of gross sales
HB 189	GRAY	TAX CREDITS Authorizes a tax credit for foster parents
HB 272	HUTTER	TAX CREDITS Provides for an income and corporation franchise tax credit for expenses incurred in retrofitting a structure to meet State Uniform Construction Code standards
HB 287	MONTGOMERY	TAX CREDITS Provides for an income and corporation franchise tax credit for ad valorem taxes paid by certain barge line, towing, and other water transportation companies
HB 297	HUTTER	TAX CREDITS Provides tax credits for certain new, expanding, and returning businesses in St. Bernard Parish
HB 410	GRAY	TAX CREDITS Authorizes a tax credit for kinship caregivers
HB 508	FAUCHEUX	TAX/SALES & USE Reinstates the exemption for certain utilities for all four percent of the state sales and use tax
HB 548	GRAY	TAX CREDITS Establishes the Green Building Tax Credit Program
HB 757	SALTER	TAX/SALES & USE Includes certain machinery and equipment used primarily to produce a news publication

within the state sales and use tax exclusion for manufacturing machinery and equipment

HB 795	SALTER	SMALL BUSINESS Provides relative to the Louisiana Community Development Financial Institution Act
HB 826	GUILLORY, ELBERT	TAX/AD VALOREM TAX Provides for an updated statewide criteria for assessing the value of business assets
HB 921	LABRUZZO	TAX CREDITS Provides a tax credit for purchase of computer equipment for use in medical offices located in medically underserved areas
HB 922	LABRUZZO	TAX CREDITS Provides for an individual or corporate income tax deduction for certain physicians and health care providers located in medically underserved areas
