HB 193	KATZ	MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL Provides for medical malpractice coverage for physicians who offer voluntary telemedicine services for the Department of Health and Hospitals
HB 197	EDWARDS	MTR VEHICLE/BUSES-SCHOOL Allows certain repair work on school buses to be performed at a repair shop which is not a manufacturer or distributor authorized provider

HB 388	GREENE	PROPERTY/IMMOVABLE Provides relative to component parts of immovable property
HB 416	ELLINGTON	TAX/SALES & USE Provides relative to the payment of sales and use tax rebate requests
HB 448	PONTI	PRIVATE SECURITY Requires security operations managers to apply for a registration card
HB 502	ARNOLD	MTR VEHICLE/DISMANTLERS Provides relative to the sale of an auto hulk to a scrap metal processor
HB 556	ARNOLD	CONTRACTORS Provides for changes in the licensing of electrical and mechanical contractors
HB 584	DOWNS	EMPLOYMENT (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to contributions to post-employment benefit funds for public employees

HB 610	WHITE	PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS Provides for electronic bidding at the local level
HB 683	ROBIDEAUX	TAX/INCOME TAX Provides relative to residency requirements for purposes of individual income taxation CONSENT
HB 814	TEMPLET	MTR VEHICLE/SEAT BELTS Increases penalties for violations for failure to properly restrain child in motor vehicle
HB 887	LABRUZZO	MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL Provides relative to limiting medical malpractice recovery in certain circumstances
HB 945	MONICA	MTR VEHICLE/TOWING Requires parishes and municipalities to provide for the removal of abandoned motor vehicles
HB 954	ELLINGTON	HEALTH/MEDICAL TREATMENT Provides relative to electronic health care transactions
HB 1040	ABRAMSON	NUISANCE/PUBLIC Provides relative to the abatement of public nuisances
HB 80	LOPINTO	ETHICS/CODE Exempts certain transactions from certain disclosure requirements
HB 82	LAFONTA	ETHICS Prohibits persons from serving on or being employed by any board or commission under certain circumstances

- HB 333 KLECKLEY INSURANCE** Provides relative to fraudulent insurance acts and penalties
- HB 359 LAFONTA EDUCATION** Requires certain school boards to provide information to certain students relative to human papillomavirus (HPV) and immunization against it
- HB 430 PETERSON ETHICS** Repeals provision for recusal for members of the Board of Commissioners of the Port of New Orleans and removes provisions permitting certain persons to serve on the board
- HB 512 PETERSON INSURANCE/HEALTH** Requires health insurance coverage for mammography examinations as provided by the American Cancer Society
- HB 868 RICHMOND CRIMINAL/SENTENCING** Amends composition of the sentencing commission
- HB 925 CORTEZ INSURANCE/HEALTH** Provides benefits for certain services performed by licensed marriage and family therapists
- HB 935 FANNIN GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION** Transfers certain agencies from the office of the governor to certain departments in the executive branch of state government and places certain agencies in the division of administration
- HB 997 MORRELL ETHICS** Prohibits former public servants in the office of the governor, including the division of administration, from being employed by or entering into a contract with a person who has a contract with the state valued at \$200 million or more for a period of five years after the termination of public service
- HB 1007 CROMER CRIMINAL/BUREAU CRIML ID** Provides with respect to background checks for persons with supervisory authority over children
- HB 1136 PEARSON PARDON/PAROLE** Provides that law enforcement officers in addition to parole officers may search a person on parole without a warrant

HB 122	MORRELL	JUVENILE PROCEDURE Provides for eligibility for parole for certain juvenile offenders
HB 234	GEYMANN	SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY Provides for the time period in which a sex offender must notify persons of their presence in the community
HB 391	WOOTON	SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY Provides with respect to the failure to pay the sex offender registration fee
HB 439	DOVE	MINERALS/MINING Provides relative to abandoned mine reclamation
HB 466	RICHARD	ENVIRONMENT/HEALTH Amends an exception to the La. Smokefree Air Act which allows smoking in certain areas of nursing homes
HB 478	BURNS, H.	CRIME Provides for resisting an officer with force or violence
HB 576	TRAHAN	SUNSET LAW Re-creates the Department of Education
HB 662	WILLMOTT	CRIME Creates the crime of home improvement fraud
HB 674	LEGER	STUDENTS Relative to public school policies prohibiting the harassment, intimidation, and bullying of a student by another student, further defines such terms as acts motivated by certain specified characteristics
HB 681	HUTTER	CHILDRENS CODE Provides with respect to the duties of peace officers or probation officers upon taking a child into custody
HB 682	HUTTER	CHILDRENS CODE Amends provisions regarding identification of children taken into custody for delinquent acts

HB 922	HENDERSON	ETHICS/CODE Allows a physician on the board of commissioners of a hospital service district to engage in certain transactions
HB 924	TRAHAN	PUBLIC OFFICIALS Requires each statewide elected official and legislator to visit at least two elementary or secondary schools each year
HB 1054	PETERSON	SCHOOLS/BOARDS Authorizes city, parish, and other local public school boards to create public benefit corporations
HB 1091	PETERSON	STUDENT/SCH ATTENDANCE Creates the Louisiana High School Dropout Prevention Act of 2008 and provides for the circumstances under which certain students may withdraw from school
HB 1117	MORRIS	ENERGY/OIL & GAS Provides for leasing and permitting of certain underground storage
HB 1138	GISCLAIR	FISHING/SHRIMP Provides relative to trawling vessels
HB 1352	GUILLORY, M.	CRIME Provides with respect to simple criminal damage to property

HB 1353 KLECKLEY INSURANCE/AUTOMOBILE Provides relative to uninsured motorist coverage

HB 624 HENRY MTR VEHICLE/OFF ROAD Increases the penalty for failure to pay sales and use taxes on certain purchases of off-road vehicles

HB 1051 KATZ HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES Provides exemptions as to related patients within the same adult brain injury facilities and establishes per unit licensing fees

HB 431 GREENE SECRETARY OF STATE (Constitutional Amendment) Removes the requirement that laws be published in the official journal of the state after enactment

HB 436 ARNOLD TAX/AD VALOREM TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for restrictions on millage increases after reappraisal and valuation

HB 643 SCHRODER DWI Provides with respect to cleansing period for prior DWI convictions

HB 1081 SCHRODER HIGHWAYS Authorizes the sale of state bridges under certain circumstances with the prior approval of the legislature

HB 392 GALLOT PUBLIC MEETINGS Removes provision which allows a public body to take up a matter not on the agenda of a public meeting

HB 581 TRAHAN STUDENTS Provides that chief administrators of schools responsible for ensuring the enforcement of immunization requirements by checking students' records must check such records annually

HB 23 GREENE CRIMINAL/CONVICTIONS Authorizes the court to admit to bail a person arrested for extradition for commission of certain offenses

HB 33 GREENE CRIMINAL/CONVICTIONS Provides relative to aggravated flight from an officer

HB 183 LORUSSO LEGISLATORS (Constitutional Amendment) Requires the legislature to provide for temporary successors for legislators ordered to active duty

HB 164	LORUSSO	LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS Provides for temporary successors for legislators called to active duty in the armed services for a period of thirty days or more
HB 283	GREENE	CHILDREN/CARE Provides procedures for child in need of care proceedings
HB 888	HENRY	BUDGETARY CONTROLS Provides for development and determination of the expenditure limit
HB 828	HENRY	CLERKS OF COURT Provides relative to the electronic filing of certain instruments
HB 446	GREENE	SECRETARY OF STATE Removes the requirement that Acts of the legislature be published in the official journal of the state

- HB 220 ARNOLD CONTRACTORS** Provides for changes to the licensing procedures by the La. State Licensing Board for Contractors
- HB 449 PONTI PRIVATE SECURITY** Provides suitability requirements for owners, officers, and directors of private security companies
- HB 593 CARMODY PURCHASING/PUB BID LAW** Increases the contract limit on certain contracts advertised and let by Caddo Parish
- HB 641 JACKSON, G. PUBLIC FACILITIES** Provides for changes to accessibility for disabled individuals in certain facilities
- HB 728 SIMON ARCHITECTS** Provides for changes to qualifications for examination of architects
- HB 1115 ARMES SABINE RIVER AUTHORITY** Increases the per diem for Sabine River Authority Board of Commissioners
- HB 1119 CHANEY FUELS/LIQ PETROLEUM GAS** Increases per diem for members of the Louisiana Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission
- HB 196 KATZ SUNSET LAW** Re-creates the Department of Health and Hospitals
- HB 304 MORRELL ETHICS** Prohibits members of boards and commissions in New Orleans from entering into certain contracts with the city
- HB 1123 LITTLE CRIME** Increases penalties for emanation of excessive sound or noise

HB 1126 POPE	CRIME Defines "person" and amends definition of "disabled person" for purposes of the crime of identity theft
HB 236 JONES, S.	ETHICS/CODE Removes population restriction to provide that an exception to the ethics code applies to members of parish and municipal governing authorities in all parishes and municipalities
HB 377 LEGER	CRIME/SEX OFFENSES Provides for registry of sex offender online identifiers
HB 557 DOVE	MINERALS/LEASES Relative to mineral lease applications
HB 642 SCHRODER	CRIME/SEX OFFENSES Amends the criminal penalties for certain sex offenses
HB 1026 DOVE	MINERALS/LEASES Provides for management of certain mineral leases by the State Mineral Board
HB 1114 GALLOT	GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION Transfers responsibility for policy planning and evaluation for the Dept. of Social Services from the undersecretary to the secretary of the department
HB 1128 BURNS, H.	MINERALS Provides with respect to allocation of penalties assessed on nonoperating nonparticipating interest owners in a unit well
HB 1142 ST. GERMAIN	FISHING/OYSTERS Authorizes the Wildlife and Fisheries Commission to develop and implement rules for the use of oyster cargo vessels
