HB 177 PONTI FIRE PROTECTION Exempts one- and two-family residences from certain provisions of the State Uniform Fire Prevention Code

HB 600 JONES, S. PORTS/MORGAN CITY Provides relative to procurement of materials and supplies by the Morgan City Harbor and Terminal District

HB 841 CHAMPAGNE PORTS/IBERIA Provides for the adoption of ordinances by Port of Iberia District

HB 1216 ARNOLD TRANSPORTATION Requires all toll facilities in the state to be interoperable

HB 715 GEYMANN MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC Directs the Department of Public Safety and Corrections not to implement the federal REAL ID Act of 2005

HB 1034 MCVEA MTR VEHICLE/COMMERCIAL Requires "hard copy" tickets to be issued for moving violations committed by operators of commercial motor vehicles

HB 1296 WILLMOTT MOTOR VEHICLES Prohibits persons from riding as passengers in truck beds while truck is traveling on interstate highways

HB 586 HARDY CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Amends witness protection provisions

HB 598 LIGI SCHOOLS/BOARDS Repeals the provision that if a member of the Jefferson Parish School Board qualifies for elective office, his school board office is thereby vacated

HB 765 HUTTER FLOODING/CONTROL Requires a parish or municipality to comply with federal flood plain management and flood insurance programs

HB 1240 HONEY **TRANSPORTATION** Provides relative to specialty license plate fees

HB 1293 ROY **LEVEES** Provides relative to the board of commissioners for the Red River, Atchafalaya, and Bayou Beouf Levee District

HB 1305 DOWNS **LICENSING** Provides relative to the issuance of explosives licenses

HB 1332 PETERSON **INSURERS/AGENTS** Requires the commissioner of insurance to publish a report regarding life insurance agent examination

HB 503 GALLOT **BOARDS/COMMISSIONS** Transfers appointing authority of members of certain boards and commissions to the lieutenant governor

HB 859 ARNOLD **HOSPITALS** Extends immunity from antitrust suits to hospital service districts

HB 977 LOPINTO **CHILDREN/SUPPORT** Provides for tax dependency deductions

HB 740 LIGI **RETIREMENT BENEFITS** (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for forfeiture of public retirement benefits by certain persons who are convicted of felony acts associated with their positions

HB 835 GEYMANN **BUDGETARY CONTROLS** (Constitutional Amendment) Disposition of state general fund monies in excess of the expenditure limit

HB 882	GEYMANN	BUDGETARY CONTROLS Restricts the transfer of monies from the state general fund for deposit into other special treasury funds
HB 1048	FOIL	MTR VEHICLE/COMMERCIAL Prohibits motor carriers from being required to sign indemnification agreements assuming liability for not at-fault accidents
HB 798	HUTTER	FISHING/OYSTERS Relative to a procedure for lifting the oyster lease moratorium
HB 1200	WOOTON	FISHING/SHRIMP Provides relative to shrimp gear fees
HB 376	DOVE	WATER/RESOURCES Provides for enforcement of groundwater management provisions
HB 1333	MILLS	HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS Provides for the licensing of forensic supervised transitional residential and aftercare facilities
