<b>HCR 27</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC</b> Provides relative to certified copies of state identification to be used as documentation in obtaining a duplicate or replacement ID card
<b>HB 44</b>	<b>GUILLORY, MICKEY</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of criminal damage to rental property
<b>HB 246</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Amends Louisiana Sentencing Commission provisions
<b>HB 250</b>	<b>GUILLORY, ELBERT</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Amends provisions of state public defender law
<b>HB 394</b>	<b>GREENE</b>	<b>CRIME/HOMICIDE</b> Amends the criminal penalties of negligent homicide
<b>HB 760</b>	<b>LAFONTA</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Amends provisions of law regarding the Louisiana Sentencing Commission
<b>HB 767</b>	<b>LAFONTA</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS</b> Provides relative to reimbursement for facilities housing inmates
<b>HB 868</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Amends composition of the sentencing commission
<b>HB 1007</b>	<b>CROMER</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/BUREAU CRIML ID</b> Provides with respect to background checks for persons with supervisory authority over children
<b>HB 1012</b>	<b>HINES</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Adds residential restrictions for persons convicted of felony crimes of violence and felony violations of controlled dangerous substances law
<b>HB 1123</b>	<b>LITTLE</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Increases penalties for emanation of excessive sound or noise
<b>HB 1126</b>	<b>POPE</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Defines "person" and amends definition of "disabled person" for purposes of the crime of identity theft
<b>HB 1136</b>	<b>PEARSON</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Provides that law enforcement officers in addition to parole officers may search a person on parole without a warrant
