HB 321	TRAHAN	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Deletes the limitation on the number of charter school proposals allowed
HB 349	TRAHAN	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Changes the charter school renewal period from 10-year periods to periods of up to 10 years
HB 463	TRAHAN	SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS Provides relative to the retention period for certain schools transferred to the Recovery School District and required reporting relative thereto
HB 580	CHANDLER	TEACHERS/SALARY Provides for a salary supplement to teachers employed in economically distressed public school systems
HB 626	TUCKER	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Provides relative to charter school funding
HB 655	TUCKER	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Provides relative to charter schools
HB 718	TRAHAN	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Provides relative to the leave of absence granted by a local public school board to an employee who subsequently becomes employed in a charter school
HB 724	MORRELL	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Requires charter schools to reimburse local school boards for the actual cost of transportation services provided by the local school board to the charter school
HB 725	TUCKER	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Extends the maximum allowable length of time a school board shall grant a school employee a leave of absence in order to be employed in a charter school
HB 813	TUCKER	SCHOOLS/FINANCE-MFP (Constitutional Amendment) Requires inclusion of certain charter schools in the MFP formula annually developed and adopted by BESE
HB 909	MORRELL	SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS Provides relative to the time period of jurisdiction of the RSD over a school transferred to it

HB 1105	TRAHAN	SCHOOLS/CHARTER Provides relative to charter school funding
HB 1187	LABRUZZO	SCHOOLS/CHOICE Establishes the Education Vouchers for Foster Children Program
HB 1347	BADON, AUSTIN	STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP Provides relative to student scholarships
HCR 44	TUCKER	SCHOOLS/FINANCE Requests BESE to include Type 2 charter schools in the MFP for funding purposes
