HOUSE RESOLUTIONS FINAL CONSIDERATION - [5 resolutions]

- 1.**HR 9** **NOWLIN** **HOUSE/RULES** Provides with respect to the content of the General Appropriation Bill
- 2.**HR 79** **GALLOT** **HOUSE/RULES** Provides for a deadline to request legislation that is required to be introduced by the introduction deadline and removes the requirement that the minutes of committee meetings contain the important points made by persons testifying and committee members
- 3.**HR 85** **PETERSON** **HOUSE/RULES** Provides for a mechanism to indicate that a legislator who is listed as the requestor or sponsor of a request by a nongovernmental entity for an appropriation has agreed to request or sponsor the amendment
- 4.**HR 127** **MORRELL** **HOUSE/RULES** Provides for procedures for impeachment of officials
- 5.**HR 141** **MORRELL** **HOUSE/RULES** Provides that certain amendments to the General Appropriation Bill, the Capital Outlay Bill, or a supplemental appropriation bill must be made public and distributed to the members at least three calendar days prior to consideration by a standing committee

- 1.**SCR 98** **CASSIDY** **HEALTH CARE** Creates the Healthy People of Louisiana Task Force.
- 2.**SCR 99** **ERDEY** **LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS** Designates "The Legend of Papa Noel, a Cajun Christmas Story" as the official state Cajun Christmas Story.
3. **SCR 123** **GRAY** **COMMITTEE STUDIES** Request joint committee to study issues regarding the final judgment between the New Orleans Firefighters Association, Local 632 and the city of New Orleans.

4. **SCR 128 CROWE** **ECONOMIC DEVELOP DEPT** Requests the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs and the House Committee on Commerce to jointly study the Hudson Initiative and creates a task force to assist the committees.

1. **SB 94 THOMPSON** **TAX/TAXATION** Increases the portion of the severance tax on timber allocated to the Forestry Productivity Fund, from seventy-five percent to one hundred percent. (7/1/08)

2. **HB 339 LOPINTO** **CHILDREN/SUPPORT** Provides for the child support guidelines
3. **HB 368 NOWLIN** **SMALL BUSINESS** Creates the Regulatory Flexibility Act
4. **HB 371 CONNICK** **CAMPAIGN FINANCE** Prohibits the use of campaign funds to pay an immediate family member with certain exceptions
5. **HB 378 ARMES** **SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES** Provides relative to noncomplex health procedures performed by certain school employees
6. **HB 550 HENRY** **PUBLIC SFTY/DEPARTMENT** Authorizes the office of state police and the office of motor vehicles within the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to implement the Unified Carrier Registration program in Louisiana
7. **HB 585 ABRAMSON** **CIVIL/INTERDICTION** Provides relative to venue for post-judgment proceedings related to interdictions
8. **HB 682 HUTTER** **CHILDRENS CODE** Amends provisions regarding identification of children taken into custody for delinquent acts

9. **HB 836** **BADON, AUSTIN** **DISTRICTS/SPECIAL** Creates the East New Orleans Neighborhood Advisory Commission
10. **HB 922** **HENDERSON** **ETHICS/CODE** Allows a physician on the board of commissioners of a hospital service district to engage in certain transactions
11. **HB 1063** **TUCKER** **LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS** Provides relative to the salary and benefits for legislative assistants
12. **HB 1104** **TUCKER** **LABOR** Creates the Louisiana Workforce Commission
13. **HB 1115** **ARMES** **SABINE RIVER AUTHORITY** Increases the per diem for Sabine River Authority Board of Commissioners
14. **HB 1141** **LEGER** **FLOODING/CONTROL** Provides relative to contracts with the Corps of Engineers for hurricane flood protection projects
15. **HB 1220** **BURNS, H.** **ENERGY/OIL & GAS** Provides for operating agreements of certain underground storage
16. **HB 1356** **ABRAMSON** **PRESCRIPTION** Provides for the prescriptive period for judgments, liens, and privileges against the state
17. **HB 1384** **MARCHAND** **PHYSICIANS** Provides for the licensure of physicians practicing telemedicine

SENATE BILLS - CONFERENCE REPORTS PENDING [9 bills]

1. **SB 159** **CRAVINS, JR.** **MOTOR VEHICLES** Prohibits minors from using any wireless telecommunications device while operating a motor vehicle. (7/1/08)
2. **SB 166** **MURRAY** **COURTS** Provides that judges elected in 2009, and elected and appointed magistrates, for the 41st Judicial District Court shall automatically revert to judges and magistrates of the civil and criminal courts of Orleans Parish should the legislation creating the 41st JDC be held unconstitutional. (gov sig)
3. **SB 179** **QUINN** **FAMILY LAW** Provides relative to reserving fruits of property as separate property. (8/15/08)

4. **SB 351 GAUTREAUX, N. STATE AGENCIES** Requires state agencies to purchase hybrid fuel or alternate fuel vehicles. (8/15/08)
5. **SB 465 WALSWORTH MOTOR VEHICLES** Revises certain driver education program requirements and certain requirements for applicants of Class "E" learner's licenses and intermediate licenses. (1/1/09)
6. **SB 542 SMITH FUNDS/FUNDING** Provides for the use of certain collections in Vernon Parish. (gov sig)
7. **SB 613 MURRAY COURTS** Provides relative to the district courts in the parish of Orleans. (8/15/08)
8. **SB 758 BROOME CHILDREN** Provides for notice of rights of natural parents relative to intrafamily adoptions. (8/15/08)
9. **SB 769 CHAISSON ETHICS** Provides relative to the Code of Governmental Ethics. (See Act)

1. **HB 159 BADON, BOBBY RETIREMENT/FIREFIGHTERS** Provides relative to provisions governing the merger of the Firefighters' Retirement System and the Firemen's Pension and Relief Fund for the city of Lafayette
2. **HB 341 JOHNSON CHILDREN/SUPPORT** Provides for the determination of income for child support
3. **HB 376 DOVE WATER/RESOURCES** Provides for enforcement of ground water management provisions
4. **HB 420 GALLOT TAX/SEVERANCE TAX (Constitutional Amendment)** Increases the general severance tax allocation to parishes
5. **HB 548 FOIL CIVIL/PROCEDURE** Provides for the continuous revision of the Code of Civil Procedure
6. **HB 598 LIGI SCHOOLS/BOARDS** Repeals the provision that if a member of the Jefferson Parish School Board qualifies for elective office, his school board office is thereby vacated
7. **HB 745 FRANKLIN DISTRICTS/ECONOMIC DEVEL** Creates the Lake Charles North Economic Development District in Calcasieu Parish

8. **HB 748 WOOTON** **CORRECTIONS** Provides for the reimbursement to private health care providers for costs of extraordinary medical expenses of inmates under certain circumstances
9. **HB 759 HARRISON** **CHILDREN/SUPPORT** Provides with respect to a material change in circumstances in child support
10. **HB 891 FANNIN** **COURTS/APPELLATE** Provides relative to appeal and review procedures for state procurement of professional, personal, consulting, and social services
11. **HB 935 FANNIN** **GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION** Transfers certain agencies from the office of the governor to certain departments in the executive branch of state government and places certain agencies in the division of administration
12. **HB 1008 ABRAMSON** **PROPERTY** Requires the filing of an act of immobilization of a manufactured home with the secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections
13. **HB 1084 ROBIDEAUX** **RETIREMENT/STATE EMPS** Relative to the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System, establishes the Hazardous Duty Services Plan
14. **HB 1108 BARROW** **PARISH/EAST BATON ROUGE** Provides relative to the East Baton Rouge Redevelopment Authority
15. **HB 1248 JOHNSON** **RAILROADS** Authorizes the Public Service Commission to execute and implement the Federal Railroad Safety Program State Participation Agreement
16. **HB 1272 TUCKER** **AIRCRAFT/AIRPORTS** Creates the Southeast Regional Airport Authority
17. **HB 1273 TUCKER** **HEALTH/DHH** Directs the Department of Health and Hospitals to develop and implement cost control mechanisms for the Long-Term Personal Care Services program and the New Opportunities Waiver
18. **HB 1388 TUCKER** **PORTS/NEW ORLEANS** Provides relative to jurisdiction of the port and membership on the board of commissioners

SENATE BILLS PENDING IN CONFERENCE [10 bills]

1. **SB 4** **SHEPHERD** **CRIMINAL PROCEDURE** Requires registration and public notice for identity theft offenders. (gov sig)
2. **SB 224** **SHEPHERD** **HOUSING** Requires that the board of each housing authority include at least one tenant and provides for a five member board of commissioners to govern local housing authorities with a certain population. (gov sig)
3. **SB 315** **NEVERS** **RETIREMENT BENEFITS** Provides for enhanced benefits for peace officers employed as arson investigators in the fire marshal's office. (7/1/08)
4. **SB 363** **NEVERS** **CIVIC EDUCATION** Provides for confidentiality of certain information on the applications of minors submitted for membership on the Legislative Youth Advisory Council and authorizes the designation of certain youth to serve in an advisory, nonvoting capacity to the council. (gov sig)
5. **SB 384** **HEBERT** **ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL** Authorizes DEQ to require facilities to keep records showing potential emissions are below Act 918 thresholds and to define potential emissions. (8/15/08)
6. **SB 499** **CROWE** **LOBBYING** Provides exception to the definition of lobbyist. (gov sig)
7. **SB 543** **QUINN** **LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS** Provides relative to legislative continuances. (8/15/08)
8. **SB 718** **MARTINY** **ETHICS** Provides relative to financial disclosure requirements of members of state boards and commissions.
9. **SB 755** **HEBERT** **HOUSING** Provides relative to the Louisiana Road Home Housing Corporation Act. (gov sig)
10. **SB 808** **MARIONNEAUX** **CAPITAL OUTLAY** Provides relative to capital outlay. (2/3-CA7s11)
