HB 206	LOPINTO	SUPPLEMENTAL PAY Deletes the one-year service requirement for eligibility for state supplemental pay
HB 289	MORRIS	INFRASTRUCTURE Dedicates certain mineral revenues to be used for certain local infrastructure needs
HB 308	LEBAS	STUDENTS Provides for participation in a dual enrollment program at postsecondary education institutions by certain high school students enrolled in BESE-approved nonpublic schools or BESE-approved home study programs
HB 497	HUTTER	FUNDS/FUNDING Specifies that Budget Stabilization Fund monies only be available for certain purposes
HB 626	DOWNS	TRAFFIC/SPEED LIMITS Provides for disposition of fines for certain traffic tickets
HB 770	LOPINTO	APPROPRIATIONS Provides relative to appropriations to nongovernmental organizations
HB 897	LABRUZZO	WELFARE Requires all FITAP cash assistance recipients and certain TANF recipients to be drug tested
HCR 160	PETERSON	FUNDS/FUNDING-BUDGET, ST Provides legislative consent for incorporation of one-third of the Budget Stabilization Fund in the official forecast for Fiscal Year 2009-2010
HCR 162	PETERSON	BUDGETARY PROCEDURES Urges and requests the division of administration to develop, conduct, and otherwise provide for an education and training program to train agency officials concerning performance-based budgeting practices
SB 18	ALARIO	TREASURY DEPARTMENT Re-creates the Department of the Treasury and its agencies. (6/30/09)
SCR 8	MARIONNEAUX	CONGRESS Memorializes Congress to adopt a balanced budget amendment.
