HB 356	FOIL (TBA)	FUNDS/FUNDING (Constitutional Amendment) Suspends deposits of excess mineral revenues into the Budget Stabilization Fund in certain circumstances <i>(Subject to Rule Suspension)(Technical Review Only)</i>
HB 378	STIAES	SEIZURES/SALES Provides relative to suspension of foreclosure proceedings upon presidential declaration of emergency or natural disaster
HB 529	CHANDLER (TBA)	WILDLIFE & FISHERIES CMN (Constitutional Amendment) Adds members to the Wildlife and Fisheries Commission <i>(Subject to Rule Suspension)(Technical Review Only)</i>
SCR 16	QUINN	CIVIL PROCEDURE Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study certain aspects of court-ordered mediation.
SCR 45	QUINN	CHILDREN Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study and make recommendations relative to the laws on relocating a child's residence.
SB 60	KOSTELKA	PRESCRIPTION Increases the prescriptive period for certain actions for harvesting and sale of timber. (8/15/09)
SB 106	CHEEK	LIABILITY Limits civil liability of health care providers and personnel during a declared emergency. (gov sig)
SB 151	DUPLESSIS	NOTARIES Provides relative to notary instructor registration and reporting requirements. (8/15/09)

SB 172	QUINN (TBA)	OWNERSHIP Provides relative to ownership of certain reclaimed lands lost through erosion, compaction, subsidence, or sea level rise. (gov sig) <i>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</i>
SB 184	MURRAY	SUCCESSIONS Provides relative to small succession procedure and ownership interest in certain immovable property (gov sig)
SB 260	CLAITOR	COURTS Provides for the jurisdiction of the East Baton Rouge Parish Family Court. (8/15/09)
