<b>HB 53</b>	<b>GULLORY, ELBERT</b>	<b>CHILDREN/VISITATION RGTS</b> Provides for grandparent visitation
<b>HB 56</b>	<b>MORRIS</b>	<b>CHILDREN/CUSTODY</b> Provides restrictions in custody or visitation proceedings
<b>HB 140</b>	<b>CHANEY</b>	<b>CHILDREN/PARENTAL RIGHTS</b> Provides for the relationship of parent and child
<b>HB 256</b>	<b>RICHARDSON</b>	<b>EVIDENCE</b> Allows the use of testimony from missing witnesses due to actions by the defendant
<b>HB 261</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>SEIZURES/SALES</b> Provides relative to the homestead exemption from seizure and sale
<b>HB 517</b>	<b>LEBAS</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS</b> Protects persons from liability, discrimination, and employment action for refusing to provide certain health care services
<b>HB 600</b>	<b>JOHNSON</b>	<b>FAMILY LAW</b> Provides for the determination of income for support purposes
<b>HB 628</b>	<b>LANDRY</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides for the delays for certain child custody orders
<b>HB 629</b>	<b>LANDRY</b>	<b>FAMILY VIOLENCE</b> Provides relative to delays for the hearing of certain temporary restraining orders
<b>HB 671</b>	<b>WILLMOTT</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Adds nurse practitioner and clinical nurse specialist to the Medical Malpractice Act
<b>HB 678</b>	<b>SMITH, GARY</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE</b> Exempts the full value of the debtor's homestead from seizure
