<b>HB 47</b>	<b>HARDY</b>	<b>STUDENTS</b> Establishes minimum academic eligibility requirements for participation by certain students in interscholastic athletics and other extracurricular activities
<b>HB 179</b>	<b>STIAES</b>	<b>STUDENT/ASSESSMENT</b> Provides relative to requirements for pupil progression
<b>HB 209</b>	<b>WILLIAMS</b>	<b>STUDENT/ASSESSMENT</b> Provides that certain LEAP test requirements shall not be applicable to students with exceptionalities
<b>HB 308</b>	<b>LEBAS</b>	<b>STUDENTS</b> Provides for participation in a dual enrollment program at postsecondary education institutions by certain high school students enrolled in BESE-approved nonpublic schools or BESE-approved home study programs
<b>HB 400</b>	<b>WILLIAMS</b>	<b>CURRICULA</b> Provides relative to required physical activity for students
<b>HB 545</b>	<b>RITCHIE</b>	<b>STUDENTS</b> Requires certain principals to provide for transfer of certain student education records
<b>HB 602</b>	<b>LEBAS</b>	<b>STUDENTS</b> Permits certain public school students to carry and self-administer certain medications under certain circumstances
<b>HB 616</b>	<b>HONEY</b>	<b>STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP</b> Permits certain students to qualify for a TOPS award based on student performance as a college freshman
<b>HB 731</b>	<b>DOWNS</b>	<b>STUDENT/SCH ATTENDANCE</b> Provides relative to the habitual absence and tardiness of students, including penalties for violations by parents and legal guardians/custodians of such students
<b>HB 767</b>	<b>WILLIAMS</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/HIGH SCHOOL</b> Provides relative to beverages offered for sale to students in public high schools
<b>HB 794</b>	<b>TUCKER</b>	<b>COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES</b> Provides for a commission to review all aspects of postsecondary education in the state and report to the legislature

**SCHOOLS/BOARDS**      Provides relative to compensation of and benefits for members of local school boards

**HB 851**      **CARTER, STEVE**

**SCHOOLS/BOARDS**      Provides relative to the powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities of city, parish, and other local public school boards
