| HCR 84 | LABRUZZO | CHILD DAY CARE Urges and requests the House Committee on Health and Welfare and the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare in consultation with the Department of Social Services study the feasibility of implementing a daycare facility in the state capitol building |
| HCR 102 | BALDONE | WILLS/LIVING Urges and requests the Department of Health and Hospitals to study the use of living wills among Medicaid recipients |
| HCR 142 | NOWLIN (TBA) | NURSING HOMES Directs DHH to continue to implement approved cost control mechanisms for the Long Term/Personal Care Services Program, the Elderly and Disabled Adults waiver, and the New Opportunities Waiver and to provide for progress reports (Subject to rule suspension) |
| HB 138 | LABRUZZO | WELFARE Increases period of ineligibility for public assistance for persons convicted of certain drug-related offenses |
| HB 535 | WILLIAMS | HEALTH CARE Establishes a statewide council within the Health Works Commission overseeing the coordination of resources involving medical simulation training centers |
| HB 780 | NOWLIN | HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES Provides with respect to the purchase of immovable property relative to the development of a replacement for the Medical Center of Louisiana at New Orleans |
| HB 781 | HINES | HOMELESS Creates the program for homeless assistance and prevention, the position of a "homeless czar", and the Louisiana Interagency Council for the Homeless |
| HB 817 | BARROW | ADULT DAY CARE Creates a state plan for adult day care centers that mandates reimbursement rates, creates a moratorium, and other related matters. |
| HB 838 | LANDRY | CHILDREN Provides for employment procedures of certain employees who deal with children |
