HRs AND HCRs FINAL CONSIDERATION - [21 items]

1. **HCR175** **P.SMITH** **STATE EMPLOYEES** Directs the commissioner of administration to study and make recommendations on reductions to state employment
2. **HR71** **P.SMITH** **HOUSE/CHAMBER** Requests the House clerk and sergeant at arms to work collaboratively to implement procedures for the inspection of deliveries made to members on the House Floor and to submit recommendations relative to House Rules prior to the 2011 R.S.
3. **HR75** **ELLINGTON** **HOUSE/RULES** Provides with respect to the adoption of certain resolutions
4. **HR98** **HARDY** **COMMITTEE STUDIES** Requests the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to review the issue of the redistricting of courts particularly as it relates to the domicile and residency requirements of judges and judicial candidates
5. **HR102** **T.BURNS** **PUBLIC BUILDINGS/ST CAPL** Requests the House Executive Committee to consider allowing open access to the wireless Internet capabilities in House-controlled areas of the State Capitol
6. **HR104** **GALLOT** **HOUSE/RULES** Provides for the report of committee on a legislative instrument
7. **HR149** **SCHRODER** **HOUSE/RULES** Provides that the name of the requesting member of an amendment to the general appropriation bill or the capital outlay bill be public
8. **HR154** **HARRISON** **HOUSE/RULES** Allows the use of the supplemental vouchered allotment to supplement the salary of a legislative assistant
9. **HCR10** **HOFFMANN** **SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES** Requests the State BESE to study school nurse salaries throughout the state
10. **HCR30** **HARDY** **STUDENTS** Requests school governing authorities to encourage students to first take standardized college admissions tests in the ninth grade

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| 1. | SCR2 | MURRAY | ETHICS Requests the Law Institute to study changes to the Code of Governmental Ethics enacted in the 2008 extraordinary and regular sessions and to make recommendations regarding those changes. |
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2. **SCR75** **MARIONNEAUX** **MENTAL HEALTH** Requires legislative committee approval of DHH contracts of a term of more than three years in duration for the privatization of any portion of the activities which were performed by certain existing facilities or programs during FY 2009-2010 and directs DHH to include certain requirements and evaluation factors in RFPs for contracts.
3. **SCR110** **PETERSON** **ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY** Continues the Louisiana Climate Change Policy Commission.
4. **SCR113** **CROWE** **U S PRESIDENT** Requests the president of the United States to utilize all the resources of the federal government to stop the oil leak in the Gulf of Mexico and to minimize its impacts on the state of Louisiana, its citizens, businesses, and wildlife and fisheries, and to expedite any necessary permits and to waive or suspend any federal requirements as necessary in order to protect Louisiana's coast, marshes, estuaries, citizens, businesses, and wildlife and fisheries.
5. **SCR121** **MORRELL** **COMMITTEE STUDIES** To direct the Louisiana State Law Institute to study and make recommendations on the revision of law regarding the transfer of a juvenile from the juvenile justice system to the adult criminal justice system.
6. **SCR126** **L.JACKSON** **HOUSING** To urge and request the Senate Committee on Local & Municipal Affairs and the House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs to function as a joint committee and convene a study group to assess affordable housing needs in our state and to research best practices and model programs to identify potential recurring revenue streams for the Louisiana Housing Trust.
7. **SCR133** **MARIONNEAUX** **COMMITTEE STUDIES** Requests study of whether to require financial institutions doing business in the state to participate in an electronic information matching program with the Department of Revenue for collecting delinquent state tax debt and to study its results.
8. **SCR134** **ADLEY** **LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS** Requests the chairmen of the Senate Select Committee on Homeland Security and the House Select Committee on Homeland Security to receive proposals on stopping the Deepwater Horizon oil leak and on the cleanup of such leak, and to forward such proposals to the appropriate state agency for analysis.

| 36. | SB135 | DUPLESSIS | INSURERS Require insurance carriers to provide utilization data within fourteen business days after a written request is received. (8/15/10). |
| 37. | SB228 | DUPLESSIS | CONSUMERS/PROTECTION Provides relative to credit reporting security. (8/15/10) |
| 38. | SB708 | CHABERT | PUBLIC CONTRACTS Extends until December 31, 2014 the \$1,000,000 contract limit for any contract by a public entity for levees not maintained with federal funds or to perform mitigation on public lands if the project is undertaken with the public entity's own resources and employees or with the resources and employees of another public entity through an agreement with another public entity. | 41. | SB774 | CLAITOR | CRIMINAL PROCEDURE Provides relative to waiver of appeal in death penalty cases. (10/01/10) |
