HB 132	WHITE	CRIMINAL/VICTIMS Provides with respect to communication between offenders and victims
HB 150	LIGI	COURTS/MAYORS Provides for the use of surplus monies in the witness fee fund for the mayor's court of the city of Kenner
HB 238	HOWARD	SHERIFFS Provides for payment of health and life insurance premiums for retired deputies and sheriffs of the Sabine Parish Sheriff's Office
HB 266	FOIL	COURTS Provides relative to the retention of certain court records
HB 283	ARNOLD	TRAFFIC/VIOLATIONS Provides that certain traffic violations be heard in certain courts
HB 294	LEGER	JUVENILES Provides with respect to the Juvenile Justice Reform Act Implementation Commission
HB 473	BURNS, HENRY	INSURANCE/GROUP-SHERIFFS Provides for payment of group insurance benefits for retired sheriffs and deputy sheriffs in Bossier Parish

HB 497	LAFONTA	COURTS/SUPREME COURT Provides for certain information to be sent to the judicial administrator of the Supreme Court
HB 506	DOVE	SHERIFFS Provides relative to dental benefits for sheriffs and deputies of the Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office
HB 550	LAMBERT	COURTS/PARISH Provides for disposition of unclaimed bail bonds in a parish or incorporated municipality located in a parish having a parish court
HB 583	EDWARDS	VETERANS Provides relative to La. Military Family Assistance
HB 623	DANAHAY	CIVIL/MOTIONS Provides relative to the recusal of judges in civil and criminal matters
HB 634	BARROW	COURTS/MAYORS Restricts the authority of the mayor as to the length of the probationary period he may impose for violation of a municipal ordinance
HB 833	KLECKLEY	SEIZURES/SALES Provides relative to security for costs of sheriff or marshal in certain proceedings
HB 980	ABRAMSON	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides relative to the interviewing of crime victims and witnesses
HB 1060	RICHMOND	CLERKS OF COURT Streamlines the fees the clerks of district courts charge in criminal matters
HB 1205	HARRISON	EMPLOYMENT Creates the Louisiana Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act of 2010
HB 1218	GREENE (TBA)	CLERKS OF COURT Requires the clerks of court to remit unused funds or to demand payment for costs in civil matters within a certain period of time (Subject to Rule Suspension)
