HB 246	POPE	TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION (Constitutional Amendment) Exempts property owned by certain disabled veterans and spouses from ad valorem property tax (<i>Technical Review Only</i>)
HB 325	STIAES (TBA)	TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes an extension of the homestead exemption and special assessment level for property damaged or destroyed by a disaster under certain circumstances (Subject to Rule Suspension) (<i>Technical Review Only</i>)
HB 987	SMITH, GARY	HEALTHCARE/RECORDS Prohibits laboratory or medical facilities from withholding test results to individuals
HB 1286	LIGI	GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION Provides relative to the organization and budget of the Patient's Compensation Fund and the Patient's Compensation Fund Oversight Board
HB 1302	BURNS, HENRY	CEMETERIES Provides for the order by which individuals can direct the manner and disposition of the remains of a military decedent
HB 1312	LEBAS	PRESCRIPTION Provides for prescription in actions for damages against home inspectors
HB 1324	RICHMOND	PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION Repeals provisions relative to compensation in certain expropriation proceedings
HB 1362	HARRISON	CHILDREN/SUPPORT Provides for child support in multiple family support cases
HB 1400	PEARSON	LEASES Provides for the delay within which to provide notice of termination of a residential lease
