<b>HCR 132</b>	<b>PERRY</b>	<b>CHILDREN/PARENTAL RIGHTS</b> Requests congress to adopt and propose to voters for ratification a constitutional amendment relative to parental rights
<b>HB 391</b>	<b>ROBIDEAUX (TBA)</b>	<b>LEGISLATION/INSTRUMENTS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for prefiling and notice deadlines for bills affecting public retirement systems ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> ) ( <i>Technical Review Only</i> )
<b>HB 738</b>	<b>LAFONTA</b>	<b>CHILDREN/ADOPTION</b> Provides relative to persons who may petition for intrafamily adoption
<b>HB 754</b>	<b>SCHRODER (TBA)</b>	<b>CIVIL SERVICE</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits pay increases to persons in state service when there is a budget deficit ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> ) ( <i>Technical Review Only</i> )
<b>HB 1318</b>	<b>HENDERSON</b>	<b>EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS</b> Provides relative to immunity of personnel while engaged in emergency preparedness activities
<b>HB 1324</b>	<b>RICHMOND</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION</b> Repeals provisions relative to compensation in certain expropriation proceedings
<b>HB 1453</b>	<b>JOHNSON</b>	<b>MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL</b> Excludes health care providers who perform certain abortions from coverage under the state and private Medical Malpractice Acts
<b>SCR 38</b>	<b>LONG</b>	<b>CONGRESS</b> Memorialize Congress to pass the Parental Rights Amendment to the U.S. Constitution and submit it to the states for ratification.
<b>SB 108</b>	<b>RISER</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides relative to legitimization of a child who has reached the age of majority. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 130</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>SOCIAL SERVICES DEPT</b> Provides for collection of child support by private party agencies. (gov sig)

<b>SB 217</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> Adopts the Uniform Prudent Management of Institution Funds Act. (7/1/10)
<b>SB 218</b>	<b>APPEL</b>	<b>CONTRACTS</b> Provides relative to security retainage under the Private Works Act. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 229</b>	<b>MARTINY</b>	<b>EVIDENCE</b> Provides relative to self-authentication. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 236</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>DIVORCE</b> Provides that physical custody of children may be shared equally in a joint custody decree. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 281</b>	<b>BROOME</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Extends provisional custody of children by mandate to grandparents. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 320</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides for the relocation of the residence of a child. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 322</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides requirements relative to an acknowledgment of paternity. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 323</b>	<b>QUINN</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides relative to Dept. of Social Services and appearance in court of an access and visitation attorney. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 361</b>	<b>SMITH, JOHN</b>	<b>USUFRUCT</b> Provides for the continuous revision of the Civil Code Articles on usufruct. (gov sig)
<b>SB 457</b>	<b>APPEL</b>	<b>CIVIL PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to the Louisiana Binding Arbitration Law. (8/15/10)
<b>SB 644</b>	<b>BROOME</b>	<b>CHILDREN'S CODE</b> Provides for the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children. (see Act)
