<b>HB 9</b>	<b>BURNS, HENRY</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Amends provisions relative to sex offender residency and presence restrictions
<b>HB 13</b>	<b>GISCLAIR</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides relative to sex offender registration requirements
<b>HB 49</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Amends the crimes of human trafficking and trafficking of children for sexual purposes
<b>HB 55</b>	<b>THIERRY</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Prohibits certain sex offenders from using or accessing social networking websites, chat rooms, and peer-to-peer networks
<b>HB 86</b>	<b>WHITE</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to sexual abuse of the physically and mentally infirm
<b>HB 110</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Provides for fees relative to the transfer of parolees and probationers across state lines
<b>HB 111</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Allows DPS&C, division of probation and parole, to charge collection fees for overdue supervision fees
<b>HB 121</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Increases probation and parole fees by ten dollars
<b>HB 122</b>	<b>WOOTON</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Provides for the imposition of a fee to defray the cost of presentence investigations
<b>HB 125</b>	<b>FOIL (TBA)</b>	<b>TAX/GAMING</b> Dedicates a portion of state revenues from gaming activities conducted on riverboats in East Baton Rouge Parish to specific entities ( <b>Subject to Rule Suspension</b> )
<b>HB 131</b>	<b>TEMPLET</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Amends the crime of failure to register to include the failure to comply with sex offender drivers' license and state identification card requirements
<b>HB 229</b>	<b>HAZEL</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Amends the definition of "aged person" in the crime of cruelty to the infirmed
