HB 55	THIERRY (TBA)	CRIME/SEX OFFENSES Prohibits certain sex offenders from using or accessing social networking websites, chat rooms, and peer-to-peer networks (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 86	WHITE (TBA)	CRIME Provides relative to sexual abuse of the physically and mentally infirm (Subject to Rule Suspension)
HB 106	MORENO	CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Requires reporting from providers of home incarceration or electronic monitoring services to DPS&C
HB 124	SMITH, PATRICIA	JUVENILE PROCEDURE Amends provisions regarding the confidentiality of delinquency hearings to allow the victim and the victim's family members to be present
HB 126	DANAHAY	CRIME/BATTERY Amends domestic abuse battery provisions
HB 129	SEABAUGH	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Provides the La. Supreme Court Committee on Bar Admissions with access to criminal history information of bar examination applicants
HB 177	ARMES	CRIME/SEX OFFENSES Amends provisions relative to the unlawful presence of sex offenders
HB 179	KATZ	JUVENILES Allows the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to make payments for care and treatment of certain youth placed in nonstate treatment programs
HB 392	HAZEL	CRIMINAL/RECORDS Provides with respect to criminal background checks for persons seeking employment
