| HB 332 | PEARSON | RETIREMENT/STATE-STWIDE Relative to the Municipal Employees' Retirement System (MERS), the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System (MPERS), and the Firefighters' Retirement System (FRS), implements the recommendations of the Funding Review Panel by providing for board membership, benefit calculation, maintaining employer contribution rates at certain amounts, and employee contribution rates |
| HB 377 | PEARSON | RETIREMENT/STATE-STWIDE Relative to state and statewide retirement systems, provides with respect to earnable compensation and service credit for any member of such a system elected to the legislature |
| HB 478 | MONTOUCET | RETIREMENT/STATE EMPS Provides for additional accruals for adult probation and parole officers in the primary component |
| HB 479 | TALBOT | RETIREMENT/CONTRIBUTIONS Relative to members of state retirement systems, increases employee contributions |
| HB 530 | PEARSON | RETIREMENT/STATE SYSTEMS Relative to state retirement systems, increases employee contributions and average compensation for calculation of benefits |
| HB 571 | ROBIDEAUX | RETIREMENT/STATE SYSTEMS Relative to state retirement systems, makes changes to provisions affected by Act 992 of the 2010 Regular Session |
