4. HB89 LIGI PUBLIC EMPLOYEES Provides relative to public access to public collective bargaining sessions and related documents
5. HB90 MACK CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Authorizes the issuance of search warrants upon electronic testimony
6. HB94 CROMER SUNSET LAW Re-creates the Dept. of Insurance
7. HB96 MORENO CRIME Creates the crime of online impersonation
