_____	<b>HB 696</b>	<b>CARTER</b>	<b>HIGHER EDUCATION</b> Provides relative to required qualifications for members of public postsecondary education boards
_____	<b>HB 867</b>	<b>HOFFMANN</b>	<b>TEXTBOOKS/MATERIALS</b> Provides relative to textbooks and other instructional materials for elementary and secondary schools
_____	<b>HB 244</b>	<b>BROADWATER</b>	<b>COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES</b> Provides with respect to the lease of property at public postsecondary education institutions to nonprofit corporations or associations to hold fundraisers that include the auctioning and sale of firearms
