_____	<b>SB 199</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides, relative to personal financial disclosure, that assessment of a late fee for which all appeal delays have expired will become executory and enforced as a money judgment. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 270</b>	<b>AMEDEE</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to personal financial disclosure. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 272</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Provides that changes to the forms by the Supervisory Committee on Campaign Finance and personal financial disclosure forms by the

Board of Ethics shall be accomplished through approval of the Committees on Senate and Governmental Affairs and House and Governmental Affairs. (8/1/14)

_____	<b>SB 274</b>	<b>CORTEZ</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to annual mandatory ethics training requirements. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>SB 394</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits persons having outstanding fines to Ethic Board from serving on any boards and commissions. (8/1/14)
_____	<b>HB 283</b>	<b>SMITH, P.</b>	<b>VOTING/REGISTRATION</b> Provides relative to registration and voting by a person convicted of a felony
_____	<b>SCR 69</b>	<b>MORRISH</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Creates the "Erin's Law" task force.
_____	<b>HB 341</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to departments of the executive branch of state government
_____	<b>HB 342</b>	<b>HARRISON</b>	<b>ELDERLY</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Creates and provides for a Department of Elderly Affairs
