**INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:**

<b>HB 187</b>	<b>BISHOP, S.</b>	<b>ASSESSORS</b> Authorizes an automobile expense allowance for the assessor in Lafayette Parish
<b>HB 206</b>	<b>THIBAUT</b>	<b>ASSESSORS</b> Provides for an automobile expense allowance for the assessors in Assumption, Iberville, and Pointe Coupee parishes
<b>HB 413</b>	<b>SHADOIN</b>	<b>ASSESSORS</b> Authorizes an automobile expense allowance for the assessor in Ouachita Parish
<b>HB 419</b>	<b>SHADOIN</b>	<b>ASSESSORS</b> Authorizes an automobile expense allowance for the assessor in Union Parish
<b>HB 695</b>	<b>BROADWATER</b>	<b>REVENUE DEPARTMENT</b> Provides relative to the types of debt the office of debt recovery is charged with collecting
<b>HB 978</b>	<b>DANAHAY</b>	<b>TAX/TAXATION</b> Provides for administration, disposition, enforcement, and adjudication of state and local taxes under the jurisdiction of the Board of Tax Appeals
<b>HB 981</b>	<b>BROADWATER</b>	<b>TAX/SALES-USE, STATE</b> Requires collection of advance payment of the state sales and use tax by certain tobacco and alcoholic beverage wholesalers
<b>HB 1097</b>	<b>HAVARD</b>	<b>ASSESSORS</b> Authorizes an automobile expense allowance for the assessors in East Feliciana and West Feliciana Parishes

The Ways and Means Committee will begin accepting written testimony regarding any tax exemption included in the Tax Exemption Budget published by the Department of Revenue, including tax expenditures for individual income, corporate income, corporate franchise, alcoholic beverages, severance, petroleum products, public utilities and carriers, sales and use, telecommunications, and tobacco taxes and tax incentives and exemption contracts. The committee will conduct hearings at a later date based on the written testimony received. A link to the form for submitting written testimony will be included at the bottom of each meeting agenda beginning on March 29, 2016.
