_____	<b>SB 90</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Amends the threshold age of the victim for certain elements and penalty provisions of the crimes of human trafficking and trafficking of children for sexual purposes. (8/1/16)
_____	<b>SB 152</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS</b> Repeals provision that any person entering an alcoholic beverage outlet is deemed to consent to a search which was declared unconstitutional. (8/1/16)
_____	<b>SB 153</b>	<b>CLAITOR</b>	<b>WEAPONS</b> Removes certain provisions regarding prosecution of the possession of a firearm with obliterated, removed, changed or altered number or mark which were declared unconstitutional. (8/1/16)
