_____	HB 298	IVEY	BUDGETARY PROCEDURES Establishes the Louisiana fiscal transparency website as a source of information for state expenditures
_____	HB 529	DANAHAY	ELECTIONS Provides for the compensation of a deputy parish custodian of voting machines
_____	HB 630	BACALA	TAX/GASOLINE TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Requires a certain portion of the monies in the Transportation Trust Fund to be used on certain projects

_____	HB 1062	CARTER, G.	FISCAL CONTROLS Requires certain contracting entities to submit information to the commissioner of administration prior to contracting with a state agency or receiving monies
_____	HB 1099	THIBAUT	AGRICULTURE Provides relative to the assessment of a license fee imposed by the Department of Agriculture and Forestry for the production of marijuana for therapeutic use
_____	HB 1121	LEGER	TAX/SALES & USE Establish notification and reporting requirements relative to retail sales made in Louisiana by remote retailers
_____	SB 49	LONG	PUBLIC EMPLOYEES Requires approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget before certain salary increases in the executive branch are effective in the last ninety days of an administration. (7/1/16)
_____	SB 136	WARD	JUSTICE DEPARTMENT Provides relative to the employment of special attorneys or counsel. (gov sig)
