_____	HB 51	LEBAS	ETHICS/DUAL OFFICEHOLDG Provides an exception from dual officeholding laws to allow a certified public accountant to hold an office on a school board and employment with a sheriff to provide financial or accounting services
_____	HB 53	TALBOT	ETHICS/CODE Prohibits public servants in state government from engaging in certain activities with public funds and assets
_____	HB 85	JAMES	ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS Exempts board members of a neighborhood security and improvement district from Tier 2.1 financial disclosure requirements
_____	HB 86	JAMES	ETHICS Provides an ethics exception to allow governing authority members and employees of a political subdivision or special district that operates parks and recreation facilities and the immediate family members of such persons to rent a facility for an event subject to certain conditions
_____	HB 323	FOIL	CONSTITUTION/CONVENTION Provides for calling a limited constitutional convention for fiscal purposes and preparations therefor
_____	HB 346	HILFERTY	ETHICS/CODE Removes an ethics exception which allows a person to be employed by a board when the person has

served as a member of the board as designee of a mayor of certain municipalities

_____	HB 385	IVEY	CONSTITUTION/CONVENTION Provides for calling a limited constitutional convention and preparations therefor
_____	HB 500	ABRAMSON	CONSTITUTION/CONVENTION Provides for calling a limited constitutional convention and preparations therefor
_____	HB 524	CARPENTER	PUBLIC OFFLS/EMPS Requires policies prohibiting sexual harassment and annual training on preventing sexual harassment
_____	HB 541	STOKES	LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the length of and subject matters considered during regular legislative sessions
_____	HCR 3	FOIL	CONSTITUTION/CONVENTION Creates a commission to study the feasibility of a constitutional convention and make recommendations relative thereto
_____	HCR 4	ABRAHAM	U.S. CONSTITUTION Provides for the selection and authority of commissioners representing the state when a convention is called to propose amendments to the U.S. Constitution pursuant to Article V
