Dec. 15, 2009: Regional public hearing in **Baton Rouge** on redistricting process & law

Jan. 5, 2010: Regional public hearing in **Lake Charles** on redistricting process & law

Jan. 11, 2010: Regional public hearing in **Alexandria** on redistricting process & law

Jan. 14, 2010: Regional public hearing in **Lafayette** on redistricting process & law

Jan. 19, 2010: Regional public hearing in **Thibodaux** on redistricting process & law

Jan. 26, 2010: Regional public hearing in **Slidell** on redistricting process & law

Jan. 28, 2010: Regional public hearing in **New Orleans** on redistricting process & law

Feb. 1, 2010: Regional public hearing in **Shreveport** on redistricting process & law

Feb. 2, 2010: Regional public hearing in **Monroe** on redistricting process & law

April 1, 2010: **Census Day**

December 2010: President of the U.S. notified of the population of each state

January 2011: State informed about number of congressional seats allocated to Louisiana

February 2011: Census data is delivered to the Legislature

February 2011: Committee hearing on Census data

Feb.-March 2011: Public hearings around the state

April 2011: Proposed Extraordinary Session to establish new Legislative, Congressional, Supreme Court, Public Service Commission, and Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) districts

Dec. 31, 2011: State constitutional deadline for the legislature to redistrict itself
