RE: Redistricting Southern Hills

Dear Mr. Speaker:

It has come to my attention that an effort may be underway to "create" an additional minority district in Caddo Parish which would include Southern Hills. Please know that as a citizen of Southern Hills, I oppose this plan in the strongest possible terms. I have lived in the Southern Hills area for 36 years and I am currently serving in term number 3 as school board representative for District 10. This district is in the heart of the Southern Hills area, and it is a majority white voting district.

First, the population of Caddo Parish does not warrant such a move. Caddo Parish is majority white and the creation of this district would leave Caddo Parish with four minority districts and not a single majority white district entirely within the Parish. This does not accurately reflect the demographics of Caddo Parish and should not pass.

Second, there is no community of interest between Southern Hills and the other areas that would make up the majority of this new district. Southern Hills is a large, but very close community that has played a significant role in the development of Shreveport from an economic, cultural and political perspective. The inclusion of Southern Hills in a minority district would potentially strip it of its identity.
