Dear Governor Jindal, Speaker Tucker, President Chaisson, Senators Crowe, Erdey, Nevers, and Representatives Burns, Cromer, Edwards, Pearson, Pugh, Ritchie, Schroder, and Simon,

I am writing to ask you to keep St. Tammany Parish in a single Congressional District. St. Tammany is split between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Congressional Districts in some of the maps currently being circulated.

Personally, I think that our interests may lie more with the other parishes along the I-12 corridor rather than our neighbors and friends on the south shore of Lake Pontchartrain. However, this has not been discussed with the public in any meaningful way. This may be a discussion for another day, but it is certainly a consideration for future redistricting discussions. Regardless of whether we remain in the 1<sup>st</sup> district or become a part of the 6<sup>th</sup> district, please keep St. Tammany Parish in a single Congressional district.
