- Act 228 of the 2013 Regular Session directs the Commissioner of Administration to transfer the Louisiana Seafood Promotion & Marketing Board from the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism. An adjustment of \$8,328,550 is added to this department.
- Act 14 of the 2013 Regular Session (HB1) contains a \$5 million appropriation within Public Safety Services from the Statutory Dedicated, Debt Recovery Fund. This statutory dedication does not exist; therefore, the figures above do not reflect this appropriation within the department.
- Funding appropriated to the Department of Natural Resources from the 20-950 Judgments section of Act 14 of the 2013 Regular Session (HB1) used to satisfy a judgment in the amount of \$4,104,286 is added to this department.
- Act 228 of the 2013 Regular Session directs the Commissioner of Administration to transfer the Louisiana Seafood Promotion & Marketing Board from the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to the Department of Cultural, Recreation and Tourism. An adjustment of \$7,831,215 is subtracted from this department.
- Funding appropriated to Higher Education from the 20-950 Judgments section of Act 14 of the 2013 Regular Session (HB1) used to satisfy a judgment in the amount of \$1,333,412 is added to Higher Education.
- Funding appropriated to the Special Schools and Commissions from the 20-950 Judgments section of Act 14 of the 2013 Regular Session (HB1) used to satisfy a judgment in the amount of \$69,405 is added to the Special Schools and Commissions.
- Due to the "more or less estimated" language associated with the additional \$69 million to the Minimum Foundation Program, the actual figure is \$69,117,217. An adjustment of \$117,217 is added to this department.
- As previously noted above, some judgments are listed under the 20-950 Judgments section in Act 14 of the 2013 Regular Session (HB1) but incorporated in the noted department's enacted figures.
