AMENDED PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative, District 54, parishes of Jefferson and Lafourche, due to the death of Representative Reggie Paul Bagala on April 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 18:601 provides that such vacancy shall be filled by special election called by the Speaker of the House; and

WHEREAS, I, Clay Schexnayder, Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana, issued on April 17, 2020, a notice, call, and proclamation for a special primary and special general election to be held on July 11, 2020, and August 15, 2020, respectively, throughout the jurisdiction of Representative District 54, parishes of Jefferson and Lafourche, for the purpose of electing a State Representative; and


WHEREAS, I have been notified by Kyle Ardoin, Secretary of State, that the time period for qualifying for this special election established in the April 17th proclamation creates election administration issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Clay Schexnayder, Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana, issue this amended notice, call, and proclamation for the purpose of, and only to the extent of, changing the qualifying period for the special primary election and special general election to commence on May 20, 2020 and end at 4:30 p.m. on May 22, 2020.

All other provisions of the proclamation issued on April 17, 2020, remain in effect and are continued.
