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| <b>HB 314</b>  | <b>PITRE</b>     | <b>PUBLIC MEETINGS:</b> Requires certain public bodies to e-mail certain information about public meetings if such bodies have the capability   |
| <b>HB 320</b>  | <b>DOWNER</b>    | <b>PUBLIC RECORDS:</b> Establishes exception for military discharge records   |
| <b>HB 337</b>  | <b>BALDONE</b>   | <b>CRIMINAL/RECORDS:</b> Provides for accessibility of criminal history records   |
| <b>HB 372</b>  | <b>FAUCHEUX</b>  | <b>CRIMINAL/RECORDS:</b> Provides for the expungement of criminal records of convictions of nonviolent crimes five years after completion of sentence   |
| <b>HB 380</b>  | <b>FAUCHEUX</b>  | <b>CRIMINAL/RECORDS:</b> Provides for the expungement of the records of the arrest for and the conviction of felony carnal knowledge of a juvenile  |
| <b>HB 506</b>  | <b>MARTINY</b>   | <b>PUBLIC RECORDS:</b> Reduces the length of time records pertaining to adult offenders must be kept by DPS&C   |
| <b>HB 516</b>  | <b>PINAC</b>     | <b>FINANCIAL INSTNS COMMR:</b> Allows the commissioner of financial institutions to make certain information available to the general public  |
| <b>HB 648</b>  | <b>LANCASTER</b> | <b>PUBLIC MEETINGS:</b> Prohibits public bodies from conducting meetings through teleconferencing   |
| <b>HB 694</b>  | <b>ANSARDI</b>   | <b>PUBLIC RECORDS:</b> Excepts certain records pertaining to security procedures and terrorist-related activities from public records laws  |
| <b>HB 695</b>  | <b>MARTINY</b>   | <b>PUBLIC RECORDS:</b> Relative to personnel records of public employees, provides for the confidentiality of direct deposit information and the employee's social security number in such records  |
| <b>HB 1052</b> | <b>LANCASTER</b> | <b>PUBLIC RECORDS:</b> Provides relative to the applicability of the laws relative to public records to certain records of the legislative auditor  |
| <b>HB 1053</b> | <b>LANCASTER</b> | <b>PUBLIC RECORDS:</b> Provides that certain test related material of the office of the state examiner, municipal fire and police civil service is confidential and requires presentations of such information to local civil service boards to occur in executive sess |
| <b>HB 1096</b> | <b>THOMPSON</b>  | <b>PUBLIC RECORDS:</b> Exempts certain records of the office of conservation pertaining to pipeline security from public records laws   |

**HB 1230 MARTINY**

**CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE:** Provides that the identities of certain persons who participate in executions of the death sentence shall be confidential

**HB 1275 FARRAR**

**CRIMINAL/RECORDS:** Provides that information and documents which are part of grand jury proceedings are not part public records

**HB 1340 CAPELLA**

**PUBLIC MEETINGS:** Authorizes Jefferson Parish Economic Development and Port District to develop marketing strategies and strategic plans, exempts them from public records law, and permits executive sessions related thereto

**HB 1649 MARTINY**

**PUBLIC RECORDS:** Creates exception to public records provisions for certain types of information in a public employee's personnel records
