Remarks:

<b>HB 107</b>	<b>WELCH</b>	<b>CREDIT/CARDS:</b> Prohibits inducements to students to entice them to apply for a credit card
<b>HB 246</b>	<b>LUCAS</b>	<b>CONTRACTORS:</b> Exempts certain persons from taking the statewide exam for electrical contracting
<b>HB 311</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>LOAN BROKERS:</b> Changes definition of "loan broker" to "consumer loan broker" and removes lenders who broker federally related mortgage loans from licensure requirements
<b>HB 335</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>LICENSING:</b> Requires all consumer lenders who change ownership to obtain approval and increases licensing fees for all consumer lenders
<b>HB 416</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>RACING/COMMISSION:</b> Changes the membership of the Louisiana State Racing Commission and provides for the selection of the chairman of the commission
<b>HB 511</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>CREDIT:</b> Provides that licensed lenders are not considered to be credit repair services organizations if the service is in connection with a loan and no additional fee is charged
<b>HB 515</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>CREDIT/CONSUMER:</b> Prohibits the business of credit repair services in the state
<b>HB 684</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>TELEPHONES:</b> Exempts communications made for political candidates, for political polls, and by newspapers qualified to be official journals from the "do not call" listing law
<b>HB 1190</b>	<b>PINAC</b>	<b>COMMERCE:</b> Provides for regulation and licensing of residential mortgage lenders
<b>HB 1700</b>	<b>DOWNER</b>	<b>ECONOMIC DEVEL/COMMUNITY:</b> Provides relative to cooperative economic development
<b>HB 1791</b>	<b>TOWNSEND</b>	<b>BANKS/BANKING:</b> Provides relative to overdraft notification agreements for attorney fiduciary accounts
<b>HB 1864</b>	<b>FRITH</b>	<b>CREDIT/CONSUMER:</b> Provides with respect to the Deferred Presentment and Small Loan Act
<b>HB 1910</b>	<b>FUTRELL</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/DEALERS:</b> Prohibits cancellation of motor vehicle franchises solely for failure to meet performance standards
<b>HB 1974</b>	<b>HAMMETT</b>	<b>ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:</b> Enacts the Louisiana Retention and Modernization Program Act
<b>HB 1982</b>	<b>FAUCHEUX</b>	<b>UTILITY/LINES:</b> Provides for the enforcement of the Louisiana Underground Utilities and Facilities Damage Prevention Law

**HCR 41 FAUCHEUX**

**AIRCRAFT/AVIATION:** Urges and requests Louisiana's participation in the 2003 Centennial Celebration of Powered Flight activities

**HCR 140 MORRELL**

**ENERGY/OIL & GAS:** Directs the House Committee on Commerce and the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs to study the reason why the increase in the price of gasoline has risen at a greater rate than the price of oil during the first three months of 2003
