<b>HB 75</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>COURTS/COURT COSTS:</b> Requires the nonprevailing party to pay court costs if the suit or the defense to the suit is frivolous
<b>HB 108</b>	<b>FAUCHEUX</b>	<b>CIVIL/GARNISHMENT:</b> Provides for service of process of garnishment proceedings on the judgment debtor
<b>HB 331</b>	<b>G SMITH</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE/RECORDS:</b> Authorizes certain persons to have access to a patient's health care information
<b>HB 353</b>	<b>TOOMY</b>	<b>PARTNERSHIP:</b> Provides when a partner ceases to be a member of a partnership
<b>HB 428</b>	<b>DURAND</b>	<b>PHYSICIANS:</b> Provides relative to the furnishing of security to accompany an appeal of a decision by the La. State Board of Medical Examiners
<b>HB 433</b>	<b>TOWNSEND</b>	<b>PROPERTY/EXPROPRIATION:</b> Provides for the reacquisition of expropriated property upon failure to begin construction
<b>HB 473</b>	<b>DURAND</b>	<b>PHYSICIANS:</b> Provides relative to stays of adjudication proceedings, decisions, and orders of the La. State Board of Medical Examiners
<b>HB 573</b>	<b>JOHNS</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for the issuance of injunctions and restraining orders
<b>HB 576</b>	<b>BOWLER</b>	<b>PROPERTY/USUFRUCT:</b> Provides for security by the legal usufruct
<b>HB 578</b>	<b>BALDONE</b>	<b>PRESCRIPTION:</b> Provides for a 30-year prescriptive period for victims of certain offenses
<b>HB 620</b>	<b>PIERRE</b>	<b>COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE:</b> Provides relative to venue for actions involving the Department of Natural Resources
<b>HB 664</b>	<b>HUTTER (TBA)</b>	<b>HIGHER ED/BD REGENTS:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Requires a common course designation and numbering system for public postsecondary education institutions and provides for penalties for boards and institutions not in compliance ( <i>Technical Review Only</i> ) ( <i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i> )
<b>HB 717</b>	<b>MONTGOMERY (TBA)</b>	<b>CIVIL SERVICE/FIRE &amp; POL:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes certain employees in the classified service to publicly express certain political positions or endorsements ( <i>Technical Review Only</i> ) ( <i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i> )

<b>HB 853</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION:</b> Grants the Second Injury Fund the right of intervention
<b>HB 861</b>	<b>CAZAYOUX</b>	<b>CIVIL/JURY TRIALS:</b> Provides relative to special jury verdicts and instructions in suits for damages
<b>HB 905</b>	<b>TOWNSEND</b>	<b>PRIVILEGES/LIENS:</b> Provides for privileges for medical providers
<b>HB 1198</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for service of the citation
<b>HB 1232</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for abandoned actions
