| HB 1535 | CROWE (TBA) | ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Provides for a toll-free hotline for alcohol abuse (SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION) |
| SB 8 | B GAUTREAUX | MARKETING/PROMOTION: Designates St. Mary Parish as the "Gateway to the Atchafalaya Basin, home of some of the best bass fishing tournaments in the world." |
| SB 98 | C FIELDS | COURTS: Increases the time limit for accepting public bids on a new facility in the 19th Judicial District to three years. |
| SB 130 | HAINKEL | SHERIFFS: Provides for circumstances where certain sheriffs pay certain premium costs of specified group insurance for certain retired officials and employees. (gov sig) |
| SB 320 | C FIELDS | CRIMINAL RECORDS: Prohibits the collection of a filing or processing fee for the expungement of criminal records in certain cases. (gov sig) |
| SB 330 | MOUNT | COURTS: Provides for the disposition of certain court reporter fees paid for the indigent transcript fund for the 14th Judicial District Court. |
| SB 364 | C ROMERO (TBA) | DISTRICT ATTORNEYS: Provides for funding of the 16th JDC district attorney. (SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION) |
| SB 376 | MICHOT | COURTS: Requires agreement of all parties to transfer a matter from small claim courts to regular district court. |
| SB 442 | ULLO | CORONERS: Provides relative to issuance of medical certifications by physicians. |
| SB 603 | MCPHERSON | DOMESTIC VIOLENCE: Provides for release of information from the Protective Order Registry to department of health and hospitals, bureau of protective |

services, the governor's office of elderly affairs, elderly protective services and the attorney general's office.

SB 657 BOISSIERE (TBA)

COURTS: Requires the appropriation of the costs of mandated positions and the costs of jury commissions and sanity hearings in the criminal district court and requires the appropriation be allocated to such court. (gov sig) **(SUBJECT TO RULE SUSPENSION)**

SB 716 HAINKEL

LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS: Establishes February 6th as Ronald Reagan Day.

SB 743 THEUNISSEN

MILITARY AFFAIRS: Provides benefits for Civil Air Patrol members injured or killed during performance of their duty. (gov sig)

SB 744 C FIELDS

DISTRICT ATTORNEYS: Authorizes the district attorney for the 19th JDC to fix the salary of his assistant district attorneys. (gov sig)

SB 746 N GAUTREAUX

COURTS: Provides relative to the civil jurisdiction of the city courts of Abbeville and Kaplan.
