Remarks:

- HB 16 DOERGE STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP:** Provides alternative to high school graduation date specified for certain students who enrolled as first-time freshman in out- of-state colleges or universities to be eligible to use TOPS awards at eligible La. institutions
- HB 432 TOWNSEND COLLEGES/FINANCE:** (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to legislative appropriations for public postsecondary education institutions pursuant to the Bd. of Regent's formula for the equitable distribution of funds to such institutions
- HB 452 MURRAY RISK MANAGEMENT:** Provides for claims made by the state pursuant to certain contracts to be subject to Risk Management
- HB 453 MURRAY PUBLIC CONTRACTS:** Provides for use of public funds to include certain liability payments
- HB 454 MURRAY PUBLIC CONTRACTS:** Authorizes public contracts to provide for indemnification under certain circumstances
- HB 455 MURRAY LIABILITY/PUBLIC:** Provides for the limitation of liability for certain public entities
- HB 458 MURRAY FUNDS/TRANSPORT TRUST:** Provides for the use of monies in the Transportation Trust Fund to include reimbursement payments by the state to any political subdivision pursuant to certain contracts
- HB 459 MURRAY FUNDS/TRANSPORT TRUST:** Provides for the use of monies in the Transportation Trust Fund to include certain costs associated with joint maintenance contracts
- HB 671 BRUNEAU FUNDS/FUNDING:** Create the Department of Justice Legal Support Fund
- HB 757 SALTER FUNDS/FUNDING:** Recreates the Teacher Supplies Fund and provides for the uses thereof
- HB 906 MORRELL PUBLIC EMPLOYEES:** Requires that privatization contracts be subject to reduction in force policies and guarantee benefits at least equivalent to those that the employees were guaranteed prior to the effectiveness of the contract
- HB 1074 FUTRELL BUDGETARY CONTROLS:** Authorizes public institutions of higher education to use surplus, unexpended, or unobligated monies for scholarships or stipends
