<b>HB 75</b>	<b>ANSARDI</b>	<b>COURTS/COURT COSTS:</b> Requires the nonprevailing party to pay court costs if the suit or the defense to the suit is frivolous
<b>HB 179</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>INSURANCE/LIABILITY:</b> Requires notice of retention of counsel on third party claims on insurance policies
<b>HB 613</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>CHILDREN/VISITATION RGTS:</b> Provides for intentional violations of visitation orders
<b>HB 622</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>CHILDREN/VISITATION RGTS:</b> Provides penalties for violations of visitation orders
<b>HB 728</b>	<b>BRUNEAU (TBA)</b>	<b>PUBLIC OFFICIALS:</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Changes the election of all officials elected at the same time as the governor to the regular congressional elections with the general election to coincide with the presidential election ( <i>Technical Review Only</i> ) ( <i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i> )
<b>HB 1021</b>	<b>DANIEL</b>	<b>MINERALS/LEASES:</b> Provides restoration of property subject to a mineral lease
<b>HB 1099</b>	<b>R CARTER</b>	<b>INSURANCE/AUTOMOBILE:</b> Provides that the owner of a motor vehicle is solidarily liable with any excluded driver who operates the motor vehicle
<b>HB 1283</b>	<b>BOWLER</b>	<b>CIVIL/LAW:</b> Provides for choice of law and forum for transactions that fall within the Uniform Computer Information Transactions Act
<b>HB 1495</b>	<b>BADON (TBA)</b>	<b>SEIZURES/SALES:</b> Requires notice of seizure to a lessee at same time the property owner is notified ( <i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i> )
<b>HB 1505</b>	<b>HUNTER (TBA)</b>	<b>MORTGAGES:</b> Requires the mortgagee to cancel the mortgage inscription ( <i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i> )
<b>HB 1506</b>	<b>HUNTER (TBA)</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for the withdrawal as counsel of record in certain circumstances ( <i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i> )
<b>HB 1518</b>	<b>R CARTER</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE:</b> Provides for the award of attorney fees in offer of judgment procedures
<b>HB 1519</b>	<b>R CARTER</b>	<b>CIVIL/JURIES:</b> Requires filing the bond for costs 60 days prior to trial
<b>HB 1539</b>	<b>HOPKINS (TBA)</b>	<b>MINERALS/LEASES:</b> Provides for lessor to receive a certified copy of a mineral lease ( <i>Subject to Rule Suspension</i> )

**HB 1581 GALLOT (TBA)**

**PRIVILEGES/LIENS:** Provides a privilege for payment of public assistance services (*Subject to Rule Suspension*)

**HB 1643 FARRAR**

**LABOR/ARBITRATION:** Provides for applicability of the Louisiana Arbitrations Law

**SB 53 M SMITH**

**CHILDREN:** Provides for qualifications of certain mediators appointed to custody or visitation proceedings.
