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| HB 85 | BALDONE (TBA) | FUNDS/FUNDING: Establishes the Louisiana Development Fund for projects, programs, or services including economic development projects, educational programs, and public health and safety (SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION) |
| HB 87 | BALDONE (TBA) | ADMINISTRATION: Requires the governor to provide for the representation of the interests of the state to congress and the federal government (SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION) |
| HB 380 | J D SMITH | CONTRACTS/BIDS: Requires state agency contracts for services to be performed by United States citizens |
| HB 385 | TOWNSEND | STATE EMPLOYEE/LEAVE: Provides for payment for unused sick and annual leave of certain unclassified postsecondary education employees who continue in employment after becoming retirement eligible |
| HB 456 | MURRAY | TAX/TAXATION: Provides for taxation of professional athletes of the Arena Football League |
| HB 465 | BALDONE (TBA) | MEDICAID: Removes cap on Medicaid revenues budgeted by hospitals operated by the LSU Health Sciences Center-New Orleans (charity hospitals) (SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION) |
| HB 470 | MURRAY | GAMBLING: Dedicates a portion of revenues derived from the Pari-mutuel Live Racing Facility Gaming Control Fund for the Compulsive and Problem Gaming Fund |
| HB 645 | BALDONE (TBA) | APPROPRIATIONS: Requires the Office of Rural Development and the Office of Urban Affairs and Development to submit reports prior to distribution of monies (SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION) |
| HB 671 | BRUNEAU | FUNDS/FUNDING: Create the Department of Justice Legal Support Fund |
| HB 702 | DURAND | PURCHASING/SERVICES: Provides for the length of certain contracts for electronic disbursement services for child support payments and electronic benefits issuance systems |
| HB 922 | J D SMITH | FUNDS/FUNDING: Provides for uses of monies in the Medical Assistance Trust Fund |
| HB 988 | DURAND | MEDICAID: Provides relative to a reimbursement exception to the medical assistance program |
| HB 995 | MURRAY | INSURANCE/GROUP-STATE: Expands eligibility of the Office of Group Benefits to include the district |

attorney and the district attorney office active employees of New Orleans

FUNDS/FUNDING: Establishes the 2004 Fund

HB 1092 TRICHE

DEFERRED COMPENSATION: Provides relative to the government deferred compensation plan

HB 1278 TUCKER

FUNDS/FUNDING: Creates the Military Economic Development and Transportation Fund

HB 1294 MURRAY

COURTS/CRIMINAL: Provides for funding of certain positions within criminal district courts

HB 1298 BALDONE (TBA)

PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS: Provides for a request for qualifications process **(SUBJECT TO RULES SUSPENSION)**

HB 1310 SALTER

FUNDS/FUNDING: Authorizes the state to forgive a portion of the mortgage payment and to redirect certain payments owed to the state by the Coushatta Industrial Development Corporation for the further development of the city of Coushatta

HB 1382 THOMPSON

SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES: Provides student loan forgiveness for certain school psychologists

HB 1412 CAZAYOUX

SUPPLEMENTAL PAY: Expands eligibility for payment of supplemental pay to certain sheriffs who are POST certified

HB 1507 CAZAYOUX

LAW ENFORCE/OFFICERS: Provides with respect to financial security for survivors of law enforcement officers
