Remarks:

- HB 74 BALDONE**      **CURRICULA:** Requires all public high schools to offer instruction in parenthood education and provides that such instruction shall be a prerequisite for graduation
- HB 1427 WRIGHT**      **BESE:** Provides for the issuance of vocational diplomas by BESE to certain public high school students
- HB 386 J D SMITH**      **STUDENT/TUITION:** Limits the fee amount charged to students for continuing education courses offered at certain postsecondary education institutions
- HB 414 J D SMITH**      **COLLEGES/TECHNICAL:** (Constitutional Amendment) Transfers public postsecondary vocational-technical education from the management and supervision of the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges to BESE
- HB 495 J D SMITH**      **COLLEGES/TECHNICAL:** Provides relative to reduction in force policies at Technical College campuses and the employment of certain faculty members who are laid off as a result of a reduction in force
- HB 567 J D SMITH**      **COLLEGES/TECHNICAL:** Provides that certain students attending public postsecondary vocational-technical institutions shall not be required to take developmental courses for completion of any certificate program
- HB 1083 J D SMITH**      **COLLEGES/TECHNICAL:** Specifies course requirements for certification as a teacher in the Technical College System
- HB 1659 K CARTER**      **EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY:** Provides relative to local school systems that are academically in crisis
- HB 1638 HEBERT**      **COLLEGES/TECHNICAL:** Reassigns the Louisiana Technical College - Teche Area Campus from Region 4 to Region 3
- HCR 79 DURAND**      **COLLEGES/FACULTY:** Requests the Louisiana Health Works Commission to convene a task force to study certain issues relative to the salaries of postsecondary education faculty in nursing and allied health occupations
- HCR 172 J H SMITH (TBA)**      **SCHOOLS/BOARDS:** Requests certain school organizations to make available to their members copies of a recent A.G. opinion confirming local school board authority to regulate student possession of cell phones on school property (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)

**HCR 197 CRANE (TBA)**

**EDUCATION/ADULT:** Creates the Adult Education Policy Task Force within the governor's office to review adult learning and literacy efforts and provides that the task force shall report recommendations to the legislature by January 30, 2005 (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
