| HB 226 | LANCASTER | PUBLIC RECORDS: Provides relative to the applicability of laws relative to public records to certain records of the legislative auditor |
| HB 1028 | RICHMOND | PUBLIC RECORDS: Exempts records related to any investigation or audit conducted by the New Orleans Office of the Inspector General and certain investigations or audits of the New Orleans Office of the Inspector General for a certain period of time |
| HB 1515 | BADON | LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEE: Provides for the salaries of legislative assistants |
| HB 122 | PITRE | ELECTIONS/CONGRESSIONAL : Provides for election to the office of U.S. representative and U.S. senator only at a general election |
| HB 840 | JEFFERSON | VOTING/REGISTRATION: Provides for the closing of voter registration seven days prior to the election |
| HB 1434 | DAMICO | SCHOOLS/BOARDS: Provides that any public school board member who qualifies for any office, except reelection to the school board, shall not be required to vacate his school board office or resign from the school board |
| HB 910 | LANCASTER | REAPPORTIONMENT/HOUSE: Provides relative to the districts of the House of Representatives |
| HB 1013 | M JACKSON | REAPPORTIONMENT/JUDGES: Provides for the election sections for City Court of Baton Rouge and for the number of judges elected from such sections |
| HB 1026 | ST GERMAIN | REAPPORTIONMENT/HOUSE: Provides for the composition of House Districts Nos. 51 and 60 |
| HB 1526 | BURRELL | REAPPORTIONMENT/HOUSE: Provides for the composition of House Districts Nos. 2 and 4 |
| HB 1566 | PITRE | REAPPORTIONMENT/HOUSE: Provides for the composition of House Districts Nos. 54 and 55 |
