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| HB 802 | K CARTER | ETHICS: Removes exception from the application of the Code of Governmental Ethics of certain employees of the office of the clerk of court relative to payment for nonpublic service |
| HB 806 | K CARTER | ETHICS: Repeals provision for recusal for members of the Board of Commissioners of the Port of New Orleans |
| HB 807 | MURRAY | ETHICS: Allows a member of the Board of Commerce and Industry to recuse himself |
| HB 1668 | LANCASTER | LOBBYING: Provides for the definition of lobbyist for purposes of lobbying the legislature |
| HB 1332 | GLOVER | VOTERS/VOTING: Changes the requirements for a voter to qualify to receive assistance in voting and prohibits a person from assisting more than two voters on an election day |
| HB 1636 | GLOVER | VOTERS/VOTING: Provide relative to voting rights of persons under limited interdiction |
| HB 1657 | DARTEZ | ELECTIONS/CANDIDATES: Requires a candidate to certify that he does not owe any fines, fees, or penalties pursuant to the campaign finance laws and provides that falsely so doing is grounds to object to candidacy |
| HB 1400 | BEARD | TRANSPORTATION DEPT: To abolish and reorganize the Department of Transportation and Development |
| HB 1679 | BEARD | WATER/RESOURCES: Creates the office of water resources within the Department of Natural Resources |
